Messrs Baylis Partners, Buckingham 203p/kg for 41kg. 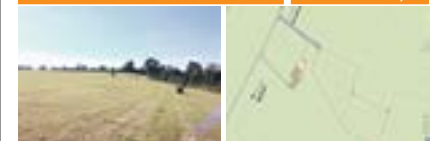

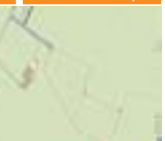
