As numbers and trade contracts across the country we some how managed to hold the yarding well above the 1500 mark and buyers appreciative of the fact. Numbers though travelling from far and wide today with a early morning arrival of an Artic from Kent. Somehow, we managed to again beat the days trading at an SQQ of 181p/kg some way ahead of the National quote. Clean empty and dry lambs helping as did the fact that lambs are now again arriving on Sunday evening. In the Euro lambs, it is no exageration to say that there is some real trade for meated lambs, it is just that there is not enough about., Today plenty of lambs to die over 410p/kg deadweight. In the Euros a top of 223p/kg for 44kg from D Mitchell, Atherstone ahead of G Fountaine at 208 and 205p/kg for 43kg. D Mitchell took 204p/kg and B C Burton 203p/kg for 44.5kg whilst T H Morris & Son 39kg at 203p/kg. Julian White also over 200p/kg on two occasions. In the heavies a top ppk of 193p/kg for 47kg from H L Goode x 2 whom showed proper finish to also see 191p/kg at 50kg. 191p/kg also to J & BD Tustian and Boulton Bros at 47kg. In the lump Euro lambs to £98 from D Mitchell at 44kg, Whilst B Burton £90.50 for 44.5kg. Overall a top of £100 for 57kg from G Bell whilst R Deeley £97 at 55.5kg and H L Goode £95.50 for 50kg. Trade frankly dearer than can be expected especially at the current poor kill out levels. Another wholesaler in the aisles indicates a shortage of Supply but only time will tell if this is regional or Continental. 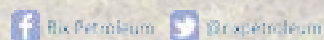

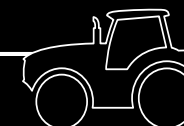
