Prime Lambs: 2192 forward SQQ 174p/kg

A huge yarding for this area at this time of year with just under 2200 penned. Lambs one of two ways, either good meat and fed or bad dying overly lean sorts. Trade expected to be drastically lower in line with the trading of last week but none the less an SQQ of 174p/kg still posted. Having genuine buyers with genuine jobs is the key. A good return throughout today with the most drastic drop in trade seen in the heavies with supply outweighing demand nationally. Lambs dealt and weighed professionally here as we continue to provide a trustworthy service to our growing number of customers. In the Euro lambs today meated sorts just as hot as last week with T E Payne & Son selling to 200p/kg for 41.5kg Beltex ahead of his 42.5kg at 188p/kg and G R Fountaine at equal money for 40.5kg. In the heavies a top of 188p/kg for 46.5kg Beltex from B C Burton with 47.5kg at 187p/kg. In the lump a top of £83 for T E Payne & Son whilst £82 for W Rogers and PD & DM Hopcraft both at 45kg. Overall today the best heavies just as dear with BMF Smith taking £115.50 for 71kg. Others at 60kg £101 and £100 and 56kg at £98. Meat and finish definitely paying. Lambs starting to be drawn lean again and buyers very adamant that finish should be present. We are consistently producing returns ahead of the deadweight if you use actual killing out percentages achieved. lean lambs though will die at least 1% less and this will be taken account for by the buyers at penside. Today more than ever highlighted the premium to be had by fully meated lambs.

Saturday 5th November Smallholders Sale

On a cold November morning the turnout to support our Second Seasonal Smallholders Sale was staggering, with the aisles full of faces from both the smallholder and the farming communities. Starting with the poultry selling to £10 per head for female Appleyard ducks, and female Crested ducks from MV Hicks. Boxes of Goldline pullets at 6-7 weeks sold to £5 per head, from S Saunders, looking a marvelous trade. Moving on to the cattle Sam Deacon sold unregistered Dexter Heifers at 12 months to £175, with Bulls at the same age to £150. Unregistered in-calf Dexter cows sold to £150. Following on with the pigs, weaners met a sticky trade, with quality selling. G Fell sold Pietrain x weaners to £40 at 11 weeks, with M R Forster selling Middle White weaners to £46 for gilts. James Brain sold in-pig British Lop gilts to £140 and £130 respectively, while empty sows topped at £146 for a Large White from James Lucas. A smaller entry of goats than expected sold to a marvelous trade, many more could have easily been sold. Laura Mobley sold in-kid Boer x nannies to £100, while Rex Thompson sold a pure Boer Billy to £88. Pygmy goat wethers from GK Dovle to £62 while little Lib Wenden. Herefordshire sold her favourite in-kid nanny to a storming £160. The sheep section was topped by KB Davies selling two very pretty Blue Texel x theaves to £144, with a Blue Texel x ewe lamb reaching £72. Kerry Hill double theaves sold to £100 from RG Elliott and son, with Jacob theaves to £70 from Dave Dimbleby. Cotswold ewe lambs to £85 for Janet Hearmon and a Cotswold Shearling ram from the Shakespeare Birthplace Trust sold to £70. Herdwick ewe lambs sold to £85 from GW Hayes, and a Ram lamb from the same stable reached £75. In-lamb Llanwenog ewe lambs also from Mr Hayes sold to £85, with empty Llanwenog ewe lambs selling to £70 from J Murray. David Doody sold Dorset Rams to £100, while Black Welsh Mountain theaves from GK Doyle sold to £64. A tidy trade across all sections concluded the day. The next smallholders sale will be held in Spring 2017 with the date to be confirmed.
