Heifers a good show and some feeding on show today not just breeding with heifers to 219p/kg and ahead of Messrs Davenport at 213p/kg and Baylis Partners 211p/kg. Top gross again with weight to the Banbury boys at £1372 and £1310.

A real trade today and some momentum as buyers wanting them at less money but also needing the meat.

Prime Hoggs: 1742 forward SQQ 175.55p/kg

Over 1700 lambs penned on a day where the men just were not interested, with two accounts not represented, with supermarkets choosing New Zealand lamb, and Christmas credit card bills tightening purses everywhere. That said with 802 lambs in the SQQ to average 176p/kg, which puts RFM firmly in the top end of the Monday trade. Quality in the Hoggs today however very changeable, and meat and finish at a marked premium over lean lambs. Smart Charollais x from Andrew Geary top of the tree today at 198p/kg at 40kg, with overnight lambs from AN Calcott & Son seeing 194p/kg at 35kg, with the next two pens at 191p/kg for the same weight. Early riser Graham Tutton showed 40kg Beltex x to 189p/kg. In the heavies, W Rogers showed smart 47kg Texel x to 179p/kg, with IA Heady also showing Texels, at 46kg to 177p/kg. Frank Page showed 46kg Beltex x to 174p/kg while R&A Adams, and Humphrey Livestock both showed 46kg Texel x to 172p/kg and 171p/kg respectively. In the lump, Euro Specs topped at £79 for Andrew Gearys 40kg Charollais x, with GL Woodard selling 42kg Charollais x to £78.50, and Ben Burton hitting £78 twice with Texels at 44kg and 44.5kg, Graham Tutton then went on to sell 42kg Texels to £77.50. Overall top today to Rich and Lynne Smith seeing 62kg Suffolk x to £95.50, and 58.5 kg to £93. John Hill showed monster Charollais x to see £92 with 61kg and Herefordshire wanderer Owen Morgan sold 59kg Charollais x to £90, while A Tarry-Smith showed Suffolks at 57kg to £87. Short keep stores £60-£67.50, with nothing particularly framey amongst them. Mid-term lambs £54-£59, with long term lambs £35-£50 only rare breeds and very small under this figure. Store lambs still a sharp trade, though just starting to feel the pressure from the slip in the fat trade. A small run of grazing ewes topped at £42 from Peter Amor.

A seasonal show of store cattle forward, with some men unable to bring cattle for various reasons, but what a day they missed out on. A Breeding Bull to start saw SF Summers sell a 2013 Angus to £1550, with feeding cows from J&P North to £810. On into the stores which saw a smart consignment of spring born cattle from Ellis Partners between 9 & 11 months with Limousin x steers at £945, with other pens around the £900 mark. Heifers from the Ellis's topped at £820, for a pen full. A change in breed saw Woods Farm Meriden sell 11 month old Angus x steers to £930, while Spabrook LTD sold Herefords to £870, for steers at 15 months. Moving up the ages saw RW Mellor sell Angus steers to £970 at 21 months, with neighbour RL Root selling Simmental x steers to top the sale at £1050. 
