Store Cattle: 96 Forward

A January Monday Sale saw a good number forward and some quality amongst them.

Kicking off the sale was AF Thompson seeing '06 Cow and Calf outfits selling to £1040. Into the store saw younger sorts from SF Summers with South Devon Steers to £760 at 11 months. Steve Eales sold Purebred Simmental Steers to £940 at 12 Months before up the ages saw Brockhall Farms Angus x Steers to £970 at 22 months. The sale topped at £995 for an 18 month Limousin x Steer from DJ & EM Fountain.

Prime Hoggs: 2069 Forward SQQ 220.45p/kg

Frankly flying and 470p/kg would not beat it on the deadweight. A yarding of limited quality compared to last week producing an SQQ of 220.45p/kg on a trade that reflected a genuine hunger for lambs whilst also a reduced premium for best end lambs with elasticity of demand on the continent last week tested too far by the continued trade for best end lambs. Today dominated by very light lambs as vendors reap the rewards of lamb price per kg. Heavies easiest sold though with an unusual requirement for cutting lambs. Today another two accounts in the lines bringing us to 15 buyers. Numbers shorter on the week but still over 2000 for the buyers to work with. Top today 270p/kg from G L Woodard for 37kg Beltex whilst little lambs ripe for the exclusive Kuwait trade saw 29kg to 248p/kg from K Evans. SLAM Farmings Belly clipped and overnight lambs saw Blue Texels at 37kg to 243p/kg. Again overnight and bellied lambs from Hillside Farm and F A Walker saw 40kg to 241p/kg. Heavier 43kg Beltex from Woody Woodward saw 241p/kg also. In the heavies a top of 223p/kg from JB Elkington for 47kg Belly Clipped Beltex ahead of Pete Batchelor at 222p/kg for 50kg and R J Summers, Thurlaston 49kg at 220p/kg. In the lump a Euro weight top of £105 at 43.5kg from M J Woodward whilst 45kg from Poulson & Co saw £102.50 and Passmore and Nunnerley 45.5kg to £101.50. Overall today 400 lambs selling in excess of £100 (How many lambs exceeded £100 at the local Abbatoirs this week?) Top today £124 at 60kg from Messrs Weatherburn with 57 and 58kg for Blue Texels to £123 and £121. Messrs Watts £120 at 58kg and Blenheim Farm Park Estates £120 at 68kg. A fair trade. Good luck to those weighing and praying.

Top of the pops from S Oakes & Son selling Texels to £90, with J&R Lowe selling Suffolk x to £86. Strength regularly £82-£86 with better end mid-term sorts well up towards £75-£80. Harder bred mediums hovering around the £70 mark with longer term bets £65-£68. Very little sold under £60 today. Trade for store hoggs simply on fire and more could have been sold to vendor advantage. Store Hogg overall average £71.93
