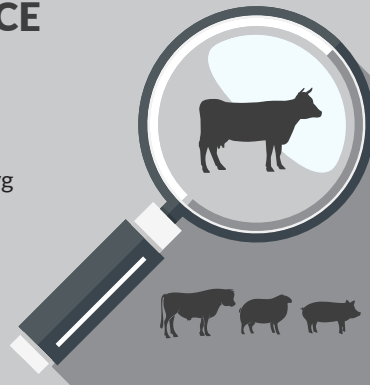

Plenty of demand for meat today with a pair of new Accounts but more and more lean lambs being presented at a time when the Export Markets are slow and unable to fruitfully sell the lean Lambs. Meat though a much swifter trade throughout and buyers willing to give fast returns with an SQQ of 270p/kg today which would have been discounted 5p by the number of poor lean lambs forwards. Meat and shape saw 329p/kg for NF & K Redfern at 38kg with 40kg to 318p/kg and others 314p/kg. M Hoyle 38kg to 308p/kg and RF & J Nichols 42kg to 300p/kg. Today Export weights properly finished regularly 280p/kg with meat first x mules 270p/kg plus. Weight saw 49kg to 306p/kg with RF & J Nichols 50kg to 300p/kg and N Deeley 46kg to 296p/kg with RF & J Nichols 48kg to 51.5kg 291 & 292p/kg. Weighted Lambs almost all 265p/kg mark upto 50kg. Lambs all in today avg £122 today including a fair percentage of lean lightweights. Export in the lump saw a top of 44kg at £130 for NF & K Redfern, Boulton Bros 45kg to £126 and MK & SM Gray 45.5kg £126 whilst 42kg £126. Weigh though pays and off the back of this a top of £168 at 65kg for Hyde Lane Farms whilst RF & J Nichols sold 60kg to £161 for Bley de Maine with 62kg from Hyde Lane to £160 with H S Underwood & Son 60kg to £158 with AK Wilson 62kg to £155 and RF & J Nicholls 61kg to £155.

Meat the key and very well rewarded throughout. Export Lambs still over ran by lean lambs and the French starting to return to sender.

Lambs need two things; plenty of Meat and Clean Bellies.
