With reduced deadweight quotations across the board, and reports of plentiful foreign boxed beef, the general consensus before the sale was of doom and gloom. However with a ringside of buyers the gloom was somewhat lifted as all stood their corners and a genuine competitive trade was seen through the ring.

Bulls-14

A good yard of bulls with some nicely finished sorts shown from The Barnes Boys, Little Lawford seeing Limousins to 200PPK with a top gross of £1518 to CH Evans & Son for Simmentals. Bull trade holding its own this week and are likely to remain wanted for next week.

Heifers-37

A trade almost of two halves. Handy weight butchers spec cattle (470-540kg) looking a proper trade as shop sales remain high. Heavier plainer heifers more difficult. Top PPK today from Parry Walters selling Limousin heifers to 224PPK, with a top gross for the same beast of £1348.

Steers-22

Very few best end steers forward today with the majority being either very heavy, or plainer sorts that could have stood another fortnight. Top PPK to Richard Heckford MBE with Blues to 204PPK. Smashing the gross figure as normal was NJ Foster with big Blue steers to £1389.

Cows-4

Difficult trading time nationwide, with very little cow meat being shifted. Top Gross to TM Gaden with Charolais slips to £1094.

A show of calves made up of nearly entirely Herefords, and what a trade! Buyers out in force with four fresh accounts ringside to bolster our already full team of buyers.

Very few continental calves forward, however best bulls topping at £300 for Blues from Whetstone Pastures Dairy, with others £280+. Native calves a super trade with best bulls to £175 for Herefords from Whetstone Pastures with the best end £130-£150.

Best native heifers to £175 for Herefords from Pilkington Farms, with rearing sorts trading £80-£120.

Spring Lambs: 310 Forward

Up over the 300 mark today to meet an SQQ of 277p/kg. A real demand for Springers with the SQQ only tempered by a large number of in door lambs and heavy end Lambs. 35kg to 41kg lambs best sellers throughout. Top ppk to 304p/kg for 35.5kg from F & C Hutsby, Walton ahead of Ted Taylor at equal weight to 299p/kg. P T Harris & Son saw 296p/kg at 40kg with genuine outdoor lambs from G S Eaton 40.5kg to 296p/kg. Top gross to 49kg £130 from Hyde Lane Farms with others from the same 46kg to £126. Ted Taylor and F & C Hutsby £125 at 47kg.

Timing

We now aim to give each area its own backing and so confirm going forward Prime Cattle 9:45am, Calves 11am and Lambs 10:15am

Prime Hoggs: 1741 Forward SQQ 226p/kg

Over 1800 with the Teeth Up Hoggs included. Trade taking some teasing out of the Buyers today but a final return placing us top of the tree with an SQQ 226p/kg equal to £4.80p/kg on the deadweight. Export Hoggs and home trade Asian weight Hoggs fiercely contested due to lack of National supply seeing the majority trading over 220p/kg for 43kg and under. Heavier Hoggs harder to fit with heavies generally trading £40 over there weight as a standard. In the Sqq averages a top of 295p/kg for A N Calcott & Son with 30.5kg Beltex ahead of Buckinghams Keith Crabtree 41kg to 290p/kg. Super Robbie saw 30kg to 285p/kg and Henry Tustian 32.4kg at 277p/kg. Messrs Claridge 41kg to 268p/kg and 45kg from Messrs Crabtree to 266p/kg. Heavies topping at 257p/kg at 46kg from Norman Deeley with Dabba Mitchell to 242p/kg for 48kg. In the lump Euro Hoggs topping at £119.50 from Messrs Crabtree at 45kg with 41kg from the same good breeding to £119. Messrs Claridge £110 for 41kg and W G King & Sons 44kg to £107. Heavies a harder sell for obvious reasons but topping out at £118 for 46kg from N Deeley. £118 for 48kg from Dabba Mitchell and £112 for 47kg from R C Hawes, Brackley. Trade very respectable today.

Heavy Lean Ewes though very swift. Top today Texels up from Amersham with Chess Valley Livestock seeing Charollais at £138. Strong Suffolks to £135 from Stimson Farming, Milton Keynes. Messrs Barnes, saw Texels to £130 two pens on the trott. Suffolks from Stimson Farming £130 and Will Moore, Leicester saw Texel x to £129. Most strong Ewes trading over £120 with huge Mules from MFH Farming to £120. Others £107 for a pen full from Humphrey Livestock with WG & SW Jones, Waddesdon trading Mules at £105. Most Mules £90 mark if strong with fat generally the discounting factor. Fat very very hard to shift. Strong Ewes very dear.

Reminder for Cull Ewe Vendors

Please ensure Ewes are NOT in-Lamb before bring them into the market.

THE LAA & DEFRA WANT US TO CONTINUE BUT NEW RULES APPLY

With immediate effect LAA members MUST implement a "drop and go" policy for vendors bringing stock to market for sale. Vendors:

Members must implement a "drop and go" policy for vendors.

This action is to prevent any sellers from entering the market. Vendors MUST be instructed to deliver their animals to the loading docks (remaining in their vehicles) whilst the market staff unload the vehicle and take the animals to their pens. The sale documentation MUST be collected by the auctioneers staff from the vendor's vehicle when they arrive at the unloading docks – Vendors MUST NOT take the paperwork to the market office themselves, or enter the market pennage area for any reason.

The LAA appreciates that this will create many challenges – no more so than developing a system by which the vendor can accept or reject the price offered at the time of sale.

Unfortunately, if we want to stay in business and protect everyone from the virus we need to find and implement solutions to these challenges.

Buyers:

The number of buyers MUST be restricted to allow Social Distancing (2 meters between each buyer). The number of buyers able to attend may be different between markets, depending upon the size and layout of your sale pens and/or sale rings, and will result in some markets being able to manage slightly more buyers than others.

Markets MUST keep a register of those that attend their sales – contact name, address and telephone number.

At the conclusion of the sale buyers MUST be asked to enter the sales office in a way that does not result in too many entering at any one time.

Buyers should be asked to sanitise on entry to the market and again on exit.
