Numbers remaining short due to the Blue Tongue conditions and Vendors really struggling to find meat. Trade around the country hard work and Abbatoirs reporting slow Sales. On this basis an SQQ of 302p/kg a real trade start to finish with, if anything, more interest in the job.

Meat the key and lean lambs discounted heavily. Top today Pure Texels from Boulton Bros at 43kg to 453p/kg with DS & LE Wadland 348p/kg and GL Woodard 343p/kg both for 40.5kg.

Nice to see Chiltern Beltex back with 44kg at 342p/kg. Shape all trading over 330p/kg and meat in general 300-210p/kg. First cross Lambs with meat 295 – 305p/kg. Lean lambs trading 280-290p/kg.

Heavies as ever a real trade topping at 335p/kg for 46kg from DS & LE Wadland whom also sold 47kg at 326p/kg. AR & J Collett 49kg at 318p/kg and Poplar Farming 48kg to 317p/kg.

Export Weight Lambs grossing to £152 at 43kg for Messrs Boulton Bros with Chiltern Beltex 44kg at £150.50 and DS & LE Wadland 43kg £144.

Weight though pays and once again week after week the highest gross in the Midlands topping at £180 for Poplar Farming, Derby and SLAM Farming, Shipston on Stour and RH Burman, Henley in Arden all with heavy weights.

William Warner £178 for 61kg and 17 others Vendors beating £160.

Trade for meat remains buoyant but in truth Sales so poor some Abbatoirs cold on killing lambs at the moment.
