### **CATTLE: 99 FORWARD**



Numbers deadly hard to find and trade simply brilliant. All corners of the ring represented and serious complaints yesterday from Abbatoirs as to the lack of numbers forward of fed Cattle. Those that have shown with us continue to return weekly and fed Cattle finding returns well ahead of alternatives. Fixed Max Commission and prompt Bacs payment are all reasons for feeders to try a few Cattle. Trade today just as quick as we have been seeing but a serious lack of finish on the whole. Meat needed next week and trade bubbling away with buyers all hoping for 30 plus each.

#### Steers:

Real breeding from Page Bros saw an extreme blue medium weight Steer take 295p/kg. Fed Steers U- from RW & HER Trivett saw 266p/kg and others 259p/kg with Fountaines best fed R Grades to 258 and Jarroms 254p/kg. Fed meat saw O+ from TJ & EW Preston to 235.5p/kg. In the gross £1835 to Page Bros with £1756 to Trivett and £1717 to Fountaine. The Gross Coloumn tells you all that you need to know when considering if to try showing some Cattle.

#### Heifers:

Certainly not the Class about that we need but some well fed sorts chased by Wholesalers and Butchers. Top 281p/kg for Page Bros with Jarrom 274p/kg both U-. Tom Reeve showing that feeding is everything when selling bucket reared Cattle to 256p/kg for R Grades and Fountaine 255p/kg. O+ finished Cattle to 240p/kg. Top gross £1631 to the Fountaine Family with others £1582 and Tom Reeve £1567. Page Bros, Jarrom and C & S Lane all breaking £1500.

#### Bulls:

A few more about albeit only the top ones suitable to even hit the side wall of the 'Dart Board' that is the Bull Kill grid. Quality with weight from J & R Lowe saw 251p/kg for Limousin Bulls whilst R Grade Blondes from JHB Hart took 231p/kg and aged Angus O grades from Tacy saw 209p/kg. Top gross £1632 from Messrs Lowe with £1377 from J H B Hart.

#### **OTM**

A few about and an super quality at the top with 34 month Heifers from Page Bros to 244p/kg with Angus 198p/kg and over 36m from C & S Lane to 182p/kg. Top Gross £1625 from Page Bros.

#### Cows;

Nationally the trade explodes but in truth it has only come up to meet where we have been trading for 3 weeks. Top today a super aged Cow from Page Bros breaking 207p/kg with others 190p/kg. Simmentals to 165p/kg and Charolais O+ to 164p/kg from Messrs Bostock. Meat and weighted finish the key with Sussex to 160p/kg from Terry Preston. Top gross £1460 to Messrs Bostock with Page Bros £1410 and Eales £1332.

A larger yarding than we would have all expected considering the Weather on Saturday through to 9am Monday morning. Just under 1600 Hoggs met the Countries highest trade of 278p/k simply miles ahead of any deadweight quote!!!. This should not hide the fcat that Hoggs remain harder to sell on the Continent and even harder domestically. Trade lifted perhaps because of National Supply being down on the day, also trade very much driven by the City trade with Lightweight Hoggs in serious vogue for the day, due simply because the usual supply of Hoggs off the Mountains could not make it down through the weather. Best end Hoggs well supported throughout and proper goods from Pete Batchelor saw 38kg to 388p/kg with 40kg to 349p/kg with 35kg from the same 340p/kg. Plenty of better end Hoggs breaking the 300p/kg mark. Heavies a hard sell throughout and little improvement on the week. Best end though always rewarded seling to 316p/kg at 49.5p/kg from P Batchelor with Poulson & Co 46kg at 295p/kg and 47kg to 289p/kg. B F Humphrey 49kg at 286p/kg. A yard of mainly lightweights but still an all in avg of £117 today across the board. Export weights still ahead of any expectations on the day that those Hoggs will have been born. £150 a smart figure for 45kg from P Batchelor with 38kg to £147.50. Our youngest farmer on the day Miss Harriet Barber sold her Blue Texels at 45.5kg to £146 and may soon be taking over the farm on the back of her success. Plenty of Export Hoggs breaking £120 with well finished 43kg to 45.5kg regularly over £120. Heavies a hard sell but perhaps a little more bite in the job and certainly no massive penalty for weight as is present locally. Top today for a clean sheet from team Batchelor selling to £156.50 at 49.5kg. J B Elkington last man in and a top of £151 for 82kg, and 57kg to £143. W Gaydon £140 and BF Humphrey £140 at 49kg, Trade certainly not bouncing back but the freefall of the deadweight system stopped by the live system once again.

Bulls today topping at £700 for R J Brendon with Herefords at 9 months. Then into the clean Stores. Steers from Wendy Taylor £895 at 8 months. Woods Farm Meriden showed Simmental Steers at 8 - 9 months to £985 and £970 with others £905. Little black bucket Heifers Limousin x from Cornwall saw £785 and £745. Dairy men out in force today when Duncan Dawes sold 15 month old Blue Steers to £1000 with others £905 and £850. Next in MK & SM Gray, Fritwell with 15 month old Charolais Steers to £990 and Angus £900 and £890.
