A much reduced show of numbers on the week, with more varied quality. However still a fantastic trade had by all for all classes forward.

Young Bulls -

A very varied assortment of bulls forward on the day.

Topping the day was FK Baxter, Merrick with another run of quality bulls at 280ppk or £2004.80.

Prime Bullocks - A pleasing show of bullocks with plenty of weight about.

Josh Trivett, Atherstone topped pence per kilo with a worthy topper, a homebred Parthenaise bullock at 666kg at 310ppk.

Not far behind were the regular vendors - The fountaine boys from Beachampton at 294ppk (674kg) First time seller P&J Evans, Northants came with a run of fantastic bullocks selling to 294 (710kg) 293(702kg) 280ppk (684kg).

P&J Evans tops at £2087, £2056 £1980 & £1915.

Prime Heifers - A handful of sweet heifers forward but as a rule more a commercial show of heifers. Handy weight heifers again from GF Fountaine topped at 321ppk with another at 300 &292ppk. Robert Nichols, Rugby back again with his machines of heifers 298ppk (782kg) 295ppk (782kg). Robert Tops the pounds per head at £2330 & £2306.

A morning where lethargy hung heavy in the air from buyers with Export sales slow as witnessed throughout last week with steadies in trade nationally. Just 2100 Lambs forward today and a very large number of lean lambs on display throughout. These would normally meet second quality export spec but currently finding a very small audience as are lambs under 42kg. Export simply oversupplied nationally with limited orders currently. Best end lambs in strong demand seeing Beltex shape at 333p/kg for M Hoyle with R Heckford 38kg to 313p/kg and DG Coombes 310p/kg at 40kg with K Buckby visiting RFM for the first time at 45kg to 300p/kg. Export lambs with quality generally 260p/kg plus and lean first cross hard percenting lambs 240p/kg plus. Heavies remain the vogue and a top of 301p/kg at 52.5kg from K Buckby with proper Blue Texel Hoggs. First draw super quality from Parry Walters with 48.5kg to 276p/ kg and 51kg to 275p/kg. Humphrey Livestock 49.5kg to 275p/kg and 53.5kg at 275p/kg. Weight really paying today. An all in avg of £111 very swift on the trade. Export gross to £135 for 45kg from K Buckby with E Glover down from Staffordshire at 45kg to £124. M Hoyle selling little shape at 36kg to £120. equalled by R Richins, M Harrison and D Coombes. Heavies though well chased seeing K Buckby 52.4kg to £158 and W & M Emery 57kg to £151 with BF Humphrey & Sons 57kg to £150. M M Hoyle £150 for 62kg. Meat the key. Masses of lightweight Export Lambs on show today lacking backs and sadly not the demand Nationally for this commodity.

A pen short of 1200 Ewes today met a trade that would be better than predicted for all classes other than the massive plethora of very lean Ewes which hold a limited audience as the Nation is well over supplied and today more than a fair share of the walking dead on show. Best end continues to buck the trend selling at extreme rates with a top of £205 for AJ Smith farming, Bedford with Texels and strength from Wally and Heather McCurdie at £202 with Beltex to £200 from RFS Ltd. Weighted Tex x from B C Burton to £194 and pure £190 from S Wise. Tups to £182 from M Hoyle with most weighted Ewes north of £160. Suffolks to £148 for F Sherratt and £143 for MFH Farming with most £120 - £130. Mules today to £130 from S Brodie and £122 from A Collett. Most trading £108 - £116. Ewes massively oversupplied with abattoir backlogs throughout the nation. Lean Ewes should be farmed to a time when demand returns.
