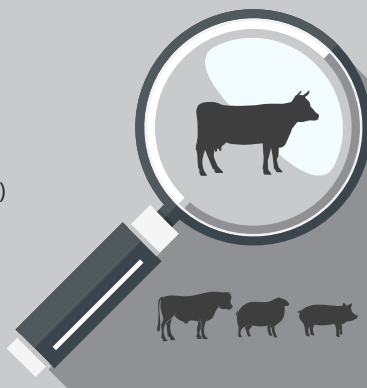

WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

CATTLE : 101 FORWARD

A surprising rise in trade. Buyers short on the ground when orders early in the day looked gloomy with some being turned around half way to Market. Thankfully the few in attendance started with a stand-on trade which grew throughout the day/ Trade now very two tier with £3p/kg the norm for Export Lambs but lean Store like sorts heavily discounted. Export Lambs seeing plenty of shape selling at 340 to 300 p/kg with best sorts more. Lean Lambs trading around the 288-300p/kg mark. Top today 379p/kg and 368p/kg for 39kg from MJ Woodward with brick like meat from J & R Lowe 367p/kg and 364p/kg at 42 & 44kg with Messrs Wadland and PJ East 41kg to 356p/kg. Weighted Lambs a real trade once again selling to huge rewards seeing a 53kg at 340p/kg for RAJ & D Hopkins and MM Clarke & Sons 49kg to 338p/kg. Robert Leach 46.5kg to 329p/kg equal with 48kg from DD Pugh. 300p/kg common place in the weight with only the very lean less money. In the lump an avg of £133 equal with the week before but for a much lighter yarding. Export lambs to £160 at 44kg for J & R Lowe with MJ Woodward £157 at 44.5kg and £156. Messrs Lowe also £154 at 42kg. Heavies in short supply and a real trade topping today at £185 for 59kg for RF Leach with £180 at 53kg for RAJ & D Hopkins and £174 at 55kg for M Haddon. R Leach and DD Pugh both breaking the £170 barrier.

Lamb trade miraculous in its lift at this time of year. Trade being held up by National shortage of Lambs. Farmers should ensure the Market is not flooded with lean lambs and instead Market all meat lambs only.
