Lethargy in the trade today as 2100 Hoggs came forward. A definite slow today from the few commission buyers on show whereas thankfully our Owner Buyers coming up trumps to return an SQQ of 294p/kg with Export weights holding a strong trade and the returns depressed by a slow in demand for bottom end half meat and mid weight Hoggs. In the Export weights today a top of 332p/kg from Char Farming, Essex with 38kg ahead of 43kg from K Crabtree at 326p/kg and Henry Tustian with 39kg to 323p/kg. Nigel Redfern showing finish at 38.5kg to 322p/kg with others 43kg from K Crabtree at 319p/kg. In the heavies meat and finish rewarded at 46kg and 320p/kg from K Crabtree others of similar description 315p/kg. A Mitchell took 48kg to 302p/kg and V R Phipps 46kg to 300p/kg. In the lump Export weights to £140 at 43kg from Messrs Crabtree with J D Lombard showing Bleu De Main to £140 at 44kg. £137 at 43kg from Messrs Crabtree and £136 for 45kg from Frank Hodgkin. Heavies a steadier trade today but still totting up to see £155 at 70kg from PA & K Barnes whilst Hull Farms dominated with pen after pen at £150 topping at £151 for 65kg. Likely trade will bounce back or hold at this point with the religious Calendars falling in the Farmers favour over the next week or so.

NOTE FROM RFM CHAIRMAN - Commission

Throughout the year prices ebb and flow according to Supply and Demand . At times when prices are low both farmers and markets struggle to balance the books but we all carry on waiting for better times.

During the past few months farmers have seen a considerable increase in values of their stock . A knock on effect has been an increase in commission being paid. Having reviewed the current trading climate we realise that our costs have not increased as fast as the current rates of Livestock. We therefore do not need to reap unrealistic Commissions and realise that this is a time for Producers to prosper not all subsidiaries that work with Farmers.

It has been decided by the Board to put a cap on commission paid per Lamb and on the Store Cattle for the next 12 months.

Our aim is continue to support all vendors on an equal footing whether selling 10 or 100 animals. We will review the situation in one years time For details call the office

March Store Cattle sale saw a nice yarding of Cattle with 55 of them finding the midnight express from Devon, Cornwall and Somerset. Trade in simple terms stronger than has been seen. Confidence in the job is being bourne from a lack of National numbers and continued margins being witnessed on those killed in recent weeks. Young Cattle now in vogue as Spring comes on the Horizon. Starting as normal with Cows. Those booked unable to come due to paperwork but promised for next week. Feeding Cows saw £1085 for a strong Hereford unassured from Trevellion Stud. Off into the young cattle and Bucket Calves done properly from Fergus White saw £830 for Simmental Steers at 12 months with Blues similar in age to £855. Another week of quality from team Semple saw £1080 with Limousin Steers 11 months and others 10 months to £1050 with £1015 and sisters £970. Tom Lowick with another draw this week seeing Heifers this time to £1030, £1010 at 12 -13months others £980. J & S White Farms Ltd, Market Harbrough graced us with size and strength to provide a wonderful advert for the South Devon breed seeing a massive £1145 for 11 month old Steers with others £1120 for 4 others. Limousin bucket calves saw £1005 12 months and £1030. Angus from W A Robertson, Pershore showed Angus at 13 months to £1120. New to this ring M Turner, Stratford Upon Avon saw Simmentals to £1135 for a trio of Steers at 11 months. Next up Anna Daly showed quality Limousin Steers to £1250 and £1100 for 14 months of age with shape and growth. Followed next by Sean Daly selling Blue Steers to £1380 at only 15 months of age and 16 month old Blue Steers to £1500 before rounding off the pen with Limousin Heifers to £1560 21-23 months. Next in saw a return to the Market of R N Lee, Spratton whom sold to £1235 for Charolais Steers at 17 months. PD & C Davenport then through the ring with weight and shape to see £1400 for Blondes at 19 months with others £1325 and £1305. Sisters saw £1395. £1360 and £1305 whilst an Angus saw £1390. A good annual consignment from AV Taylor, Banbury topped at £1190 for a trio of Simmentals at 18 months with others £1070 and £1000 with sisters to £940. Traditional British Friesian Cows really paying their keep for RH Trivett & Son when selling his dairy progeny to £1335 for a trio of Blue Steers at 19-20 months and Limousin at £1330 and Blues £1290. Sisters topped at £1210. Robinson Bros next in with Angus and Stabilisers both to £1130 for Steers at 20-23 months whilst a single 18 month strong Stabiliser took £1175. The famous Albert Goolding saw a wonderful average of over £1200 seeing South Devons to £1280 at 24 months for Steers and equal age Charolais £1265 and Simmentals £1275. Heifers saw £1255 at 21 months. Long distance travellers saw Cornish Cattle top at £1190 for 23 month old Limousin Steers and a big group of hairy hill bred Angus to £1160.

Trade very much buoyant and we hope it remains throughout the supply chain so it proves sustainable.


