Lambs of all weights heavily contested but light weights again a real show stopper. In the Euro section today a top ppk of 317p/kg for S Wise Texels at 41kg ahead of SM & JM Lambert at 315p/kg for 37.5kg and S Wise again 314p/kg for 39.5kg with Frank Badger also 305 and 308p/kg for 37kg and 38kg. In the heavies a top of 259p/kg for 51kg from FJ Tombs & Son with others from the same good farm 48.5kg to 254p/kg whilst J & BD Tustian 47kg to 253p/kg. In the gross, high percenting lightweight lambs topped at £130 for 41kg from S Wise whilst 44kg from P F Edwards £125. Stuart Wise 39.5kg to £124 and Merrick and Julie Pinny 41kg to £121.
