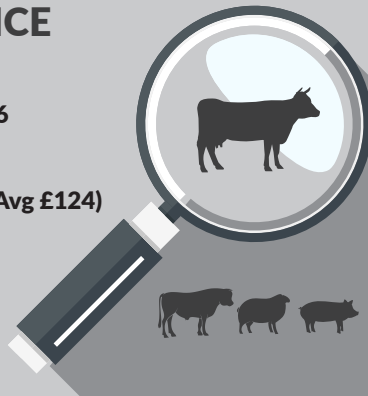

A good show of clean and all Accounts active at the ringside with all corners covered. Quality out in force and a joy to welcome new faces to the ring bringing fully finished cattle to these shores. Appreciated by all buyers;

Steers;

Width the order of the day with quality throughout. Page Bros back showing the goods with medium weight Steers to 306p/kg and heavies 298p/kg others 297p/kg. Smart harder Steers to 288p/kg from Messrs Page and a welcome to D W Gurney & Son with compact strong Steers to 280p/kg. Buyers all keen but the emphasis very much on finish and Vendors are advised to refer to the calculator. Feed still very much paying and should be seen as a prudent investment. Gross figures the top of the pops to see a massive £2122 for Page Bros with others £1961 and £1892. R Grades all into 230's and O Grades often well towards 220p/kg with bad percenters looking very dear.

Heifers;

Mainly weight on display today but smart finish from Page Bros passing the magical 300p/kg mark at 301p/kg ahead of a smart Parthenaise from H & J East, Kidlington at 280p/kg and Fountaines at 270p/kg and 265p/kg for Parry Walters. R Grades upto the mid 240p/kg for soft finished Cattle with O Grades inexplicably towards 230p/kg with buyers needing meat. Weight pays and a top gross of £1846 from Messrs East, Kidlington with Page Bros £1758 and heavy Angus girls £1738 for N Wallington, Piddington.

Bulls;

A nice little show topping at 240p/kg for Messrs Fountaine with Limousin and Alan Tacy 220p/kg for Angus and Lincoln Reds. Top Bulls £1574 for G R Fountaine & Son, Beachampton. Heavy Shorthorns to £1516 from GM & LD Robson.

OTM's

Heavy strong South Devons from Messrs Lee seeing a proper weighted old boy to £1715.

Cows;

The edge off Cows and trade sluggish especially in the absence of finish. The wrong time of year for lean Cows and they are heavily penalised. Hard to find numbers and even harder to find meat. The net cast far this week with Cornish Lambs in the lines. Numbers short nationally and as a result a flying trade at an SQQ of 281p/kg, simply ballistic. Meat rewarded throughout and a sign of how hard producers are finding conditions the lack of weight on show. Despite this an all in avg of £124 and at our capped commission too, only the producers reaping the full reward they deserve. Top ppk today a massive 320p/kg at 45kg from B C Burton with Pete Bodily small but perfect at 35kg to 317p/kg. R Richins then controlling things with 44kg to 316p/kg with 39 and 40kg 315 and 316p/kg. Dabba Mitchell 38.5kg to 312p/kg. Meat and finish in massive reward. Heavies just on fire to see a top of 298p/kg at 47kg from B C Burton with D G Coombes 294p/kg for three pens in a row 50.5kg to 49kg. Lots of little lambs in today but for those that have caught meat early they look a great business swapping super light weights for £100 plus and then reinvesting in well bred but small Store lambs. Export weight lambs topping at 45kg for £144 with R Richins 44kg to £139 and B Burton 45.5kg £137. SLAM Farming 45kg to £135. Overall a top today of a massive £170 from J B Elkington at 63kg. T Wood Texels to £161 at 57kg and J B Elkington £160 at 63kg. Di Hopcraft £157.50 at 60kg and Paul Edwards 57kg to £155.50. Trade simply flying as numbers fall short. Likely this trade will bring some forward but those with lean lambs will be especially discounted next week as it is show week.
