#### **CATTLE: 27 Forward**

A short entry of on the whole better quality was forward, several regulars missing due to harvest and worried by talk of slow sales and deadweight prices in retreat. However those farmers that had stock forward saw a tremendous trade for all types as strong buyer presence at ringside pushed averages up over 202p for clean cattle.

BULLS: An entry dominated by weight saw blonde's sell to £1439.30 from Townsend Partnership with others to £1017.50 from Mr. Page.

STEERS: An entry of mostly native-bred steers were good to sell with demand at ringside outstripping demand. Richard Fountaine and Family found a proper heavyweight Limousin to top the sale at 226p, with fed Herefords from Tom and Roger to 207p and as ever more are needed to supply demand.

HEIFERS: Trade of the day, with competition in all corners of the ring and everything in demand. The Elliott men topped the sale with a Limousin at 219, followed by Parry at 216p. Native breeds sold to 214p for Lincoln Reds from The Fountaine's and 208p from Richard Wright. The trade of the day was the run of dairy bred, heavyweight Herefords from The Barnett Men which sold to £1326.92 and averaged £1202.43 for the load.

OTM's: Steadier but not a disaster, top price was £1568.80 for a Blonde bull from Townsend Partners, Shorthorns cows sold to £1252.68 from Messrs Cockerill, with worked devon cows to £689.73.

FARMERS: As the work load on the land increases with harvest, do not hesitate to draw cattle and send them to auction. Cattle are wanted by the large company of buyers at ringside and I am on hand to receive and handle your cattle from 7a.m. onwards.

A seasonal entry of 29 Store Cattle, was on offer to a smaller company of buyers at ringside who like everyone had an eye on the weather and food situation. Cattle on the whole were well shown, the sale was topped at £1000 by a 25 month old Charolais heifer from The Wixey Family, who sold yearling heifers to £885. Steers sold to £915 for a 17 month Charolais from Mrs McMahon. A run of 7-9 month old cattle from Robert Carlton sold well to £735 for the Steers and £590 the Heifers.

A very tricky trade with buyers having no appetite for numbers with poor killing out percentages rendering them uncompetitive. An SQQ of 186p/kg a stand on rate but in truth a large number of poor lambs amongst the 2300 yarding. In the Euro a top of 215p/kg both for IM Allen & Partners, Leicester with Beltex and R Richins, Oxford with Beltex both at 40kg. B Burton 42.4kg at 206p/kg and Messrs Hopcraft 202p/kg at 42kg. In the heavies R Richins 49.5kg to 210p/kg with 48.5kg 192p/kg and Messrs Hopcraft equal. Overall a top of £106.50 for S Wise today at 57kg with Messrs Richins £104 for 49kg and Humphrey Livestock £98 for 55kg. A very difficult trade as lambs begin to show the weather and numbers flood out across the country.


