Handy weight mediums from Amorise Farms to 293 and 288p/kg R grade regularly north of 250p/kg if finished fully.

The bullocks putting plenty of weight down with a 818kg Charolais form J Morris selling to £2110.

Amorise Farms passing the £2000 mark as well at £2076. With several more bullocks in the £1900's. Meat and style was in demand.

Quality in demand today and 300p/kg broken by T Kenealy at 302p/kg but top 303p/kg from G R Fountaine & Son. R grades all well past 260p/kg.

Mr Terry Kenealy topped the heifer section pounds per head with a marvellous run of red Lim heifers, to £1862, £1793, £1781 and £1752.

GR Fountaine & Son not far behind with his cracking heifers at £1829 £1721 and £1710, it was Fountaine just piping Terry to the post at 303ppk topping the heifer PPK with others at 295 and 287.

A light offering of bulls with variable quality topped at 270 ppk from S Friswell, Northfields Farm or £1544.40.

A fantastic start to the overages with Edward Hulls Charolais Stock Bulls selling to £2771.60 & £2267.

Edward again making his trip up from Essex more than worth while, selling Black Hereford Cows to 215ppk, 211ppk 210 205 204ppk or £1804 £1725 £1701.

Topping the cows pence per kilo was Andrew Geary, Yew Tree Farm at 222ppk.

Merris Bros Farmers Ltd, Northampton topped the pounds per head in the cow section with a 173 month cows at £1899.52 and another at £1829.52.
