A Sqq of 175p/kg and at 45% kill representing 3.89p/kg deadweight with no grader!!! Top today in the Euros to 36kg to 200p/kg from Famington Farms. Messrs Mundy 35kg to 189p/kg equal with P J Hicks and M J Woodward. Heavies topped at 196p/kg for 48kg from Humphrey livestock whilst the same 50kg to 188p/kg and W G Batchelor 55kg to 182p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs at 45kg to £84.50 for PD & DM Hopcraft and £84 for 45kg from Stimson Farming.
