CATTLE: 53 Forward

PRIME CATTLE: 55 HEAD

An increased number of cattle were forward, with the entry all commercial beef, with no showstoppers in the entry. The usual buyers were in attendance, but all complaining of poor outlet sales, slow butcher trade for certain cuts and an abundance of meat available. Trade would be quieter on the week, but possibility highlighted by the quality of cattle forward.

BULLS: 2 HEAD

Just the two this week, topping at 170p for a dairy bred continental from Mr. R.J. Smith, others sold to £777.

STEERS: 4 HEAD

A short entry met a steady demand from ringside, topping the sale and section was a handyweight Limousin from Cedric Styles which realized 180p. Simmentials from Steve Powell sold to 167p.

HEIFERS: 33 HEAD

The bulk of the entry, with the vast majority off grass sold well to the usual buyers but at less rates than previous weeks. The section and sale was topped by a lightweight Limousin Heifer from Pete Green. Messrs Tivey sold native breeds to 178p for Angus's, with heavyweight Blue's from Ratcliffe Farms to 177p. Heavyweight heifers sold to £1247.85 from Lodge Farm, Limousin's to £1149 from Lodge Farm.

OTM's: 16 HEAD

A larger entry saw extra buyer strength at ringside, everything in demand and more needed to supply buyers needs. Topping the section at 139p was an overage steer from Messrs Stanton, other overage clean from Geoff Ratcliffe sold to 119p for Hereford Heifers. Eddie Litchfield sold continental cows to 119p, top price per head was £1036 from Derek Hancock. The section averaged 109p overall.

Sadly an SQQ of 167p/kg one of the highest for the day with trade painful Nationwide. Better end lambs still the order of the day selling to 200p/kg from R Richins, Oxford whilst J B Elkington 192p/kg at 36kg. Pete Jarrom 40kg to 188p/kg. Heavies saw meat wanted and our heavy lambs a sharp trade in comparison to alternatives. Top 183p/kg for 48 and 49kg from B C Burton with others 173p/kg. In the lump £80 top for export spec lambs with 41kg to £76.50 from Messrs Jarrom and £75 for 42kg from H Collins & Sons. Overall today a top of £89.50 from B C Burton at 49kg with 48kg £88 equal with S Brodie.

CHRISTMAS SHOW RICH FRUIT CAKE

Oven Temperature: 300 F, 150 C, Gas 1-2

Ingredients:

3 Large Eggs 1 tablesp Brandy

12 oz/325 g Currants 4 1/2 oz/125 g Sultanas 4 1/2 oz/125 g Raisins 3 oz/75 g Glace Cherries 2 oz/50 g Candied Peel A little lemon rind 7 1/2 oz/215 g Plain Flour 1/2 teasp Mixed Spice 1/2 teasp Cinnamon 6 oz/175 g Butter 6 oz/175 g Brown Sugar

- 1. Line an 8 inch round cake tin, using 2 thicknesses of greaseproof paper. Tie a double band of brown paper/newspaper around the outside.
- 2. Mix the currants, sultanas, raisins, cherries and peel.
- 3. Cream the butter, sugar and lemon rind until pale and fluffy.
- 4. Add the beaten eggs and the brandy, a little at a time, beating well after each addition.
- 5. Fold in the flour. Then fold in the fruit.
- 6. Put in to the prepared tin, spread evenly.
- 7. Place in the pre-heated oven on a layer of brown paper/newspaper, in the lower part of the oven. Cook for approximately 2 3/4 hours
- 8. When the cake is cooked, leave it to cool in the tin, and then turn out onto a wire rack.
- 9. Store by wrapping in greaseproof paper and place in an airtight tin.

When judging, the cake will have to be cut in half to see the distribution of the fruit etc. Inserting a skewer will only achieve the taste of the cake. The cake can still be covered in marzipan and icing ready for using at Xmas.


