A break after the Bank Holiday and a trade that was on fire quite frankly. Butchers all needing meat today with the addition of a new Butchers account who could not even make a start.

In the Steers a top today for some meat and finish from Padray Farms,
Northamptonshire to see 230p/kg for a smart lean Charolais. Weighted Steers from C
W Thomas saw 209 and 200p/kg to take top gross at £1418 and £1346.

Heifers as ever wanted and all grades represented today selling to 240p/kg for a smart sort from Parry Walters ahead of Padray Farms at 229p/kg and Parry with two others 224 and 220p/kg. Weight though pays and CW Thomas again top at £1340 with Padray Farms £1331. Quite simply today cattle a really wanted commodity and clearly counter sales are buoyant.

Over 2600 Hoggs today with sheep travelling all from around. A sale of two halves. Spec Hoggs as dear as ever and plenty over the 200p/ kg mark whilst heavy weight Hoggs becoming increasingly depressed by over supply and unprecedented low sales value on Smithfield. An Sgg though which shows all Hoggs of 45.5kg and less tells its own story at 191p/kg. Spec Hoggs dear, heavyweights over supplied, simple. In the Euro Spec today some quality from Henry Tustian bred by Messrs Wadland, saw a top of 254p/kg at 39kg and 243p/kg at 40kg whilst 44.5kg 222p/kg. JL & L Burton 205p/kg at 38kg. In the heavies a top ppk of 213p/kg from Messrs Tustain at 46kg with R C Hawes 186p/kg at 46kg and Phil Darby, R Randall & Son 183p/kg at 46kg. In the lump Euro lambs to £100 for 39kg Beltex from Messrs Tustian whilst 44.5kg £99 and 40kg £97. Overall £100 also for 56.5kg from Henry whilst RWH Fenemore £98.50 for 67kg. A yarding of 2000 under 45kg Hoggs really would encourage some trade with Hoggs in spec currently dying every bit as dear as the Spring lamb premium whilst Europe continues to demand Hogg meat in preference to Lamb.

How long the trade will stay up is debatable. Top today Laban Partners with a single Texel at £136 and a pen full of Smart if a little thick at £130. Top Suffolks sold just before the end from David Wilson at £120 whilst first pen sold in the yard from Gate Farming saw Cheviots to £120 for a set of 3 Tups. R Randall & Son sold Charolais to £117 and T Addison, Newport Pagnall saw Texels to £117 and Bob Tofield £114. Mid range Ewes dearer on the week whilst the strong ewes were at stand on. Mules today reaching a massive £94 from Upton Mill Farm with R Burman, Redditch £92.50. Easy Care from J O Adams to £90 and and Lleyn Ewes from JCB Farms, Derbyshire £86. Welsh Ewes to £59 today from Messrs Meusal!!!!

Starting to see a lot of clearings up in the store lamb section now, with very few runs of quality. Top today however from P Mardell with Milk Sheep springers to £70. Hoggs topping at £66 for Charollais x from North & Partners, Kidlington, with Passmore & Nunneley seeing £65.50 also for Charollais x. Very few short keep hoggs forward today, trading between £64-£66, mid- term sheep £55-£62, with long term small sorts £45 and under. Hoggs and lambs seeing a nice trade to £50 per life or £100 per family from Charlie Randall.

Store Cattle 324 Forward

The April Fair once again with the show and sale competing for the Perpetual Rose Bowl. Numbers hard to find as a National shortage of Store numbers seems to be becoming apparent. Trade reflecting the shortage and perhaps the dearest we have seen for many years, cattle for cattle. Our Judge today Andrew Hallifield, Derbyshire went on to place the best pen or 3 Steers for Steve and Elaine Friswell, Brinklow and best pen of 3 Heifers to C H Evans, Wroxall. Overall Champions 3 Simmental x Blue Heifer from Messrs C H Evans which went on to sell to £1300 at 14 months of age travelling to Herefordshire.

We started the sale with a couple of Smart Simmental Cow and Calf outfits from new vendor, S Evans, Towcester selling to £2000 for a three and half year old with a December born Simmental heifer calf at foot. A matching unit sold to £1810.

We started well with Wolverton Farm Estate selling Herefords at 7 to 11 months of age to £720 for heifers and £710 for Steers. Real quality from John Peebles, Shipston on Stour saw smart Limousin Steers at 11 months to £1060 with others £1010 and heifers £945 and £925. The Semple family saw another week of quality with Steers to £995 at 12 months of age and younger sorts £950 and £900. JA & S Wrench sold Limousin Steers to £970 at 11 months of age and Angus Steers at 10 months of age £860 for a pen full. A single 11 month old Beef Shorthorn Heifer from R W H Fenemore & Sons sold to £740. The Annual consignment of quality from B C Mawby saw 14 month Limousin Steers £1100 and 12 months £1090. R & NJ Bryson saw Angus Steers saw their best consignment yet to £805 at 11 months. Prize winning Steers from the counties main Stable of Steve and Elaine Friswell saw the Champion Steers to £1100 at 11 months of age!!! R W Cross kept up the momentum bringing power and size to £1150, £1140 and £1105 at 13 to 15 months of age. Similar aged Simmental Steers from R S Beaty £1015. Momentum maintained up the ages today and if anything the older cattle even dearer as the Nation seemingly now lays short of aged Cattle as deadweight Specs have encouraged the finishing of younger lightweights. Feeders and graziers though still require older spec for certain jobs. Heart of England Farms sold Limousin Steers at 15 months to £1190. Angus Steers once again showing lots of demand with M R Beaty & Son £1140 for a pen full at 15 months of age with a marvellous 14 month Angus Steer to £1220. Next in a single smart Simmental heifer at 15 months from C H Evans to £1300 before the champion pen of heifers reached the same at only 14 months with sisters £1155. A nice consignment from RAJ & D Hopkins hit £1205 at 19 months. Others £1130 and £1120 and the consignment of 24 averaging £1073. A bucket calf from D & E Trice saw a Blue at 18 months £1090 and JS & N Morley sold 11 Lincoln Red Steers at 19 months all to £1080. R Elliott, Yelvertoft sold Limousin Steers at £1125 for 18 months before Rob Milner topped at £1165 for South Devons. New vendor H J Douglass, saw out-wintered Charolais Steers at £1270 for 23 months of age and sisters £1120. Herefords from FE & CJ Barnett to £1145 at 23 months. Last man in R Stephens saw a Limousin Steer to £1265 and its older sister a proper traditional feeder £1220

Frankly flying and the Sale ring again showing the true transparency of Supply and Demand. Cattle trade unsustainable at these rates on current returns at the final reckoning but for those selling today a day to remember in the diary.

Ewes & Lambs



A run from JE Strainge & Sons saw Suffolk Double Theaves with twin Charollais x Lambs to £75 per life twice or £225 per outfit, with others at £71. Holly Weaver sold nicely grown Texel x Hoggs with mainly single Texel Lambs to £70 per life, with K Butcher travelling from the east to see a Romney Theave with twins to £210 for the family.
