Numbers very hard to find as meat dries up and farmers look towards Ground Work. Buyers today commenting on the real lack of quality and meat on show for the day. We didn't feel the need to document the finish time but perhaps more important to producers is the trade which is reported as; An SQQ of 313p/kg well ahead of expectation and comparison despite this being the week after the end of Muslim Festivities. Export Hoggs smart trade throughout with best meat in good demand and wanted throughout. Top today 371p/kg at 38kg from D W Gurney & Son whilst R W Barker down from Lincolnshire at 360p/kg for 45kg. E A Hull up from Essex 39kg to 354p/kg. D W Gurney then taking the honours 44.5kg at 353p/kg. Heavies well chased for best end but cutting Hoggs a harder Sale and the only real commodity to have dipped as London Meat Market struggles for Sales on the week. Meat though a massive trade with 49kg to 367p/kg for RW Barker & Son. 46.5kg Beltex from D W Gurney & Son 353p/kg and 48kg 336p/kg. Heavy Hoggs generally £3 mark but those over 52kg harder sale throughout. An all in avg of £136 with a wealth of poor under finished Hoggs in today. Export Hoggs topping at £162 for 45kg R Barker, Lincolnshire and 44.5kg £157 for Gurney who also sold 45.5kg at £156 and E A Hull 45kg to £150. Messrs Gurney 43kg to £150 on several occasions. Overall the Lincolnshire Stock taking the honours in the Sheep and Cattle with R W Barker & Son selling to £185 at 61kg and 49kg to £180 with D Taylor, Hethe to £173 for Suffolks and K Attfield down from Peatling for £172. Messrs Taylor then £170.50.

Meat the Key and good Hoggs look set to remain a very favourable trade as we now head towards Quarbani.

Lambs to be sold first from the 1st of May and we hope that more firms come on to buy Lambs in the coming weeks.


