

Lambs:

Much the same in terms of Trade today and numbers. Trade seeing 267p/kg SQQ despite steadies elsewhere. Farmers seemingly desperate to clear numbers and a large amount of under finished Lambs forward today at a time when 40kg to 43kg Lambs are harder to sell as Export Sales dry up. Better meat lambs the best chased throughout albeit not the premium that we are used too. Top today 318p/kg at 42.5kg from G R Fountaine & Son with M J Woodward 41.5kg at 316 & 313p/kg and L Russell & Son 39.5kg at 304p/kg. Weight continues to be easier to sell at the moment with 46kg to 290p/kg from WV Harris & Son and Woody 51kg to 288p/kg. Messrs Wright 47.5kg to 286p/kg and Humphrey Livestock 49.5kg to 283p/kg. An all in Avg of £114.50 today a real rate of return when the number of lean lambs being sacrificed is taken account of. In the lump Export weights to £135 for 42.5kg from G R Fountaine & Son with M Woodward 41.5kg to £130 and C R Hill £130. Overall a top of £157 for 57.5kg from S Beesley with £150 for 55kg from Humphrey Livestock and £147 for M Woodward. Plenty of meated and weighted lambs over £140. Lamb trade suffering from European weather and Holidays. In this time vendors must draw lambs heavier and thicker.


