Trade today falling swiftly as Abattoirs report unworkable trades in Europe and as multinationals cut the kill. That said buyers with plenty of accounts placed the trade In the top few for the day with an Sgg of 196p/kg including the superlights. In the Euro spec a top of 224p/kg for Page Bros at 37.5kg ahead of a Beltex from Nigel Chantry 215p/kg for 34kg with Page Bros also 214p/kg. In the heavies a top of 205p/kg for 46kg from Messrs Seckington whilst W & M Emery 49kg to 202p/kg equal with MJ Woodward and FJ Tombs & Son for 46kg. In the lump Euro lambs topping at £91.50 for 45kg for Messrs Seckington with Phil Darby £91 for 45kg and Messrs Stone House Farm 44kg at £90 twice. Overall a top for weight today 55kg to £109 for J Fowkes with MM Clarke & Sons £104.50 for 54kg. Trade now likely to steady but with weaning and harvest perhaps Supply will rectify any issues. 
