

Rugby Farmers Mart Monday 24th October 2022.

We broke another record!! 161 cattle through the ring! A huge Thank-you to all our customers buyers and sellers along with staff, for all of your support.

The 161 consisted of -14 young Bulls 56 Heifers 73 Steers 18 OTM cattle.

#### Young Bulls.

Nigel Hollick was back with his homebred quality, Honesberie Farms sold Limousin Bulls to 291ppk or £1943.

J&R Lowe with another cracking Limousin at £1861.80

The bull trade very similar with them O+ dairy bred bulls still £1400/£1650.

#### Clean Cattle

73 Steers.

Another cracking run of bullocks through, Frank Page of Page Bros topped the day with a beauty at 334ppk or £2211.08.

Best end bullocks 295ppk/334ppk with weight no problem.

Commercial bullocks with plenty of belly and not as much behind would be steadier on the week following the national trend.

#### Heifers - 56 forward.

Close placings at top place for ppk. Jack Peacock, Norfolk sold to 316ppk for some sweet little heifers and Terry Kennealy sold to 315ppk for his run of fantastic cattle.

But Josh, no one can seem to knock you off the leading pounds per head with a homebred heifer from the Trivett's at £1941.

Same story with the heifers as bullocks. Carrying a bit of middle isn't the in look at the minute. When killing percentages taken into account of these sort of cattle still ahead of other outlets. We don't mind if their farm assured, little, large, customers for all cattle.

#### OTM cattle.

RFM is here to Market not sell. The downturn in trade predicted and as a result numbers held back. An SQQ of 240p/kg when selling felt like an up hill battle but by the end of the day left us 20p/kg ahead of some of the days results and the deadweight even lower at only 480p/kg if you can get the lambs in. A large entry of Store like lambs both here and nationally seeing very low kill percentages. Major national buyers showing evidence of cheap supplies coming forward at speed. Best end lambs in short supply and well chased seeing a top of 296p/kg at 38kg for R Richins with J Robb up from Bucks to sell 41.5 Beltex to 292p/kg with R Richins 44kg at 282p/kg. Meat needed throughout and in short supply. Meated lambs still travelling past 250p/kg regularly for Export weights with second rate lean selling 225 - 240p/kg. Heavies a slight steady but more palatable than the lightweight and export weight. Topping at 282p/kg for 47kg from E Brain & Son and fed meat 46kg from Humphrey Livestock at 273p/kg. Meat and weight at 50kg from JT Jeyes & Son saw 50kg to 270p/kg with others 49kg to 269p/kg. An all in avg of £111 a nice return on current times. Export weight lambs topping at £124 for 44kg from R Richins with J Robb £121 at 41.4kg and G Fountaine 44kg to £118. Good export weights regularly breaking the £100 barrier. Weight pays and that the theme for the day selling to £162.50 at 72.5kg from R J Batchelor. This expert shepherdess £148.50 at 63kg and £146.50 at 60kg, selling others £142 to £145, Harcomb Farm Partnership a first time to these Shores taking £142 back to the Cotswolds. Trade needing to be monitored by farmers whom should not forward half meated lambs with such over supply nationally. £4.80dw at 43% does not come to alot per kg live!!!

Blue Texels to £160 from J Jenkins. Charolais from the Colinswood team of Oliver and Pete selling to £155 with plenty of Texels £150 plus. Suffolks to £170 for a horse of a ewe from P Brander and £132.50 from P Davenport. Suffolks generally £120 mark albeit light ewes £10 step backwards. Mules to £124 from P Mobley and £110 for Evergreen Enterprises. Mules generally either side of £100. Lean Ewes out in massive force and gobbled by feeders not Abattoirs.

A good number forward and again ahead of last years trading. Today a Sale facing a full ring with old and new faces returning to buy genuine Cattle. The theme of the year being held up with quick turnaround of 90 day or less Cattle in hot demand and long term forage hungry cattle harder to fit. That said trade in truth very fair throughout with returns very rewarding to those getting Cattle ready from a very hard summer. Bulls saw a new vendor R Dawson travelling down the M69 to sell Charolais Bulls 10 months to £1045 and £1000. Again starting with youth a bang of a start from New Pastures Care Farm selling Blue Steers at 8 months to £1075. Team Semple saw their weekly loyal army of buyers at ringside to see £1280 for Limousin Steers at 11 months others £1110 and £1100 with sisters to £1090 and £1055. Kirsty Badger showed an earlier than usual consignment to see 14 month Limousin Steers to £1280, £1250, £1200 and Blues a season older £1200 with Sisters £1190 for 14 months. Bucket runs then from Evergreen Enterprises saw 15 month Angus Steers to £980 and £910 with Blue Heifers 18 months £830.

Shape and youth from S Daly seeing 16 month Blue Steers to £1550 and Sisters £1420 before showing a boat of a Limousin Steer at 21 months £1600!. A very genuine run of Cattle from RS Beaty and Son. Topping at £1300 for 19 months of age this strong Simmental found its way back to the Welsh Borders. Steers topping at £1195 for a pen full of 5 Simmental Steers 14 to 18 months, others £1065.
