PRIME CATTLE: 68 Head

A good entry of clean Cattle and Bulls but lacking numbers in the OTM's, all regular buyers at ringside but several complaining of poor sales and an abundance of cattle coming off grass. Trade has to be quoted less on the week, but all cattle met competition from the 11 men at ringside.

BULLS: 3 Head

An entry of mainly dairy breeds, lacking finish sold to a top of 174p for a Simmental cross and £953.52 from Catesby.

STEERS:31 Head

A mixed entry for quality, saw weight everywhere in the entry and strong competition from ringside, trade has to be quoted easier. Top price was 208p paid for a Blue from Mr.R.D.G. Taylor, heavyweight Limousin's sold to 205p from Roger and Tom Elliott. Heavyweight cattle sold to £1350.90 and £1350.50 from Brian Smith. Roger and Tom sold others to £1345.92.

HEIFERS: 30 Head

Excellent numbers saw demand strong at ringside, with all buyers operating, but at a price. The Trivett Family continue to bring topping Limousin cattle and they again topped the market at 224p and 220p with a cracking pair of heifers. Parry Walters sold to 219 with Frank Hodgkin at 218 and 217p. Heavyweights realised £1362.58 from Ces and Family, others to £1349.42 from Avon Valley Farm.

OTM's:4 Head

Where are the cows!!! Extra men at ringside, with an old friend making a welcome return trade sharper and all types wanted. Top price was 130p for a Beef Shorthorn from The Elliott Family, Kislingbury. Simmental's from Messrs Webb sold to 127p. PRIME LAMBS:1384 Forward SQQ 180.7p/kg

A few more about but still no busting numbers as producers struggle for meat. The Trade today must be reported as a vast improvement and an SQQ of 180.7ppk the dearest in the country seemingly. Trade vastly improved with a yarding that in part would be the leanest we have seen this year with only a few runs of meat putting things right. Two new accounts popping up out of the woodwork today helping things along for the best end sort with 240 lambs trading over 185p/ kg. $(185p/kg \times 46\% = £4.02p/kgdw)$. In the PPk a top today of 205p/kgkg from Shannon Mitchell at 37.5kg for Beltex, 43.5kg Texels 198p/ kg from R Richins, Oxford. J & S White, Market Harbrough 197p/kg for 39kg Beltex. In the heavies a top of 183p/kg for 46kg from B C Burton with Parry Walters 46.5kg at 180p/kg and Stone House Farm 47.5kg to 177p/kg. In the lump lambs topping for Euro weights at £86 for 43.5kg from Messrs Richins and £85 for 44kg from Richins and Stone House Farming. AEJ & FJ Claridge £84 at 45kg. Overall heavies the hardest trade of the day with local abattoirs giving heavy lambs away into London at 3.45p/kgdw (that makes a 23kg carcass £79.35 which in live terms at 46% is a 50kg lamb before any cost of kill or transport is added!!) Nothing sold as low as that today with top 50kg to £89 from Messrs Peebles. Overall a top of £96 for 56kg from BMF Smith whom had £95 also for 54 and 56kg. Passmore and Nunneley £94.50 57kg and G Bell, Skipton £93 equal with Mark Martin and S & J Farming with 54 to 56kg.

Trade a welcome boost but not all out across the country. We must monitor and producers must forward finished lambs to help propagate a continued price rise.
