A change of voice for the yarding of just over 100. Trade very swift and perhaps a move forward on the week. More than a smattering of O- and P grade cattle today but in truth compared to deadweight returns these proving to be very dear.

Steers:

Proper finishing from H & J East with South Devons to 300p/kg and others 290p/kg with Robert Mitchell 281p/kg. R Grades all well over 260p/kg. Top gross was the East beast showing weight finish and shape seeing £2309 and £2292 for H & J East. J R Morris sold weighted Charolais Steers with finish to £2071.

Heifers;

Best end chased throughout and topped today at 317p/kg for J R Morris, Lutterworth ahead of H & J East at 313p/kg for a medium weight and Parry Walters 313p/kg for lightweight Heifers. R Grades all well over 260p/kg and most over 270p/kg. Simply flying. Top gross £1853 to H & J East with £1834 for Messrs Morris whom also took £1832.

Bulls:

Bulls a wanted commodity and we cant seem to find them. Best end on fire with a Charolais from Inkerman Charolais selling to 290p/kg at 17m and 790kg. Traditional Herefords 233 and 234p/kg from Lower Ingon Farms. Top gross £2280

Cows:

All we can ask is to have the best of the trade and we did just that with an SQQ of 266p/kg for a yarding of 2440. A massive fall in National trade as lean lambs flood the country and Export orders limited with local Abattoirs limiting kill dates. The major note for the day is that lower end Export orders such as France are slow and so very lean lambs have audience only to feed. Today 1000 lambs more than expected with 500 only booked in as of Sunday night!!!!!!! Best end lambs retaining last weeks trade but run of the mill Export lambs 40p/kg back on the week and yet still worth more than the mornings deadweight quote. Top today 40kg at 415p/kg for P Jarrom at 40kg with close friends M Woodward 40kg at 325p/kg and socialising partner C R Hill 45kg 324p/kg. Meat rewarded and those selling meat seeing demand with Woodward again 41kg to 317p/kg and FH Everett 43kg to 314p/kg. Best end lambs still 300p/kg plus. Weight again a better trade than lighter lambs seeing real demand for the Home trade. B Humphrey & Sons showed meat with 48kg to 298p/kg and N Deeley 51kg to 294p/ kg, MM Clarke & Sons 46kg to 291p/kg and 50kg 290p/kg. An all in avg of £118 and Export weight topping at £146 for 45kg from C R Hill whom sold 44kg to £138 and 45kg to £138 for K Tunstall and Messrs Everett £135 for 43kg. Heavies the trade of the day selling to £157 at 56kg from MM Clarke & Sons with £157 for FJ Tombs & Son at 57.6kg and also 54kg to £151 and N Deeley 50kg to £150. Trade slipping fast as the hours wear on. Vendors best not to panic and instead look to feed from the bag. Determinants of the decreased demand are short lived and a continued dumping of half meat lambs into the Supply will only act to prolong the depression.
