A Bank Holiday yarding and so little over 1000 lambs in the alleys. Trade must be reported as lethargic as fridges remain unemptied following the end of the previous weeks back lash from the feast. That said an SQQ of 187p/kg representing well over £4 deadweight equivalent. Meated lambs selling well but plenty of O-2's on show today and trade must reflect that. In the Euros a top of 238p/kg for Texels from Mocklers Blue Texel Stud seeing fed 40kg grab lots of attention. Texels from PA & M Barnes bucked the trend for the day of lambs under 40kg being hard to shift, instead they took 39kg at 210p/ kg. B C Burton showed proper meat at 44.5kg and others 203p/kg. In the heavies a top of 204p/kg for Rouge Lambs from Messrs Wolfe of Leicester whilst MM Clarke & Sons 196p/kg for 46kg. In the lump Euro lambs topping at £95 for 40kg from Mocklers Blues. B C Burton £91.50 twice for 44.5kg and heavier lambs £45kg to £90. Overall £111.50 for 63kg from FJ Tombs & Son with others £102 at 55.5kg. BMF Smith £101 for 52.5kg. Midland Environmental £100 for 54.5kg Texels. Trade treating all on there merit but lacking bite. That said returns very favorable for the time of the year. Trade reflective of quality
