A good yarding of Genuine Store Cattle with numbers dragging buyers long distance. Vendors today saw 52 from John Salmon of Cornwall and a very genuine show of Beef Shorthorn from the Mallaber Family down from Derbyshire. Locals today turning out the goods also with all qualities catered for.

Feeding Bulls;

A new addition as standalone section for the fixture saw a good entry and serious enquiry. W E James Farming, Stratford Upon Avon Topped at £1230 for Limousin Bulls at 12 months with others £1070 and a Stock Bull to £2000. Young Bulls saw Messrs Bostock Sell 7 month Charolais Bulls to £1050. Bucket Blue Bulls from RW & HJ Dewes saw 9 month age to £800. Messrs Mallaber then sold Shorthorn Bulls to £1070 for yearlings with 11 month old to £940 and £930.

Younger Cattle reported as less money in the North but perhaps dearer on the week here. M Squires kicked us off at pace selling Angus Steers to £1115 at only 10 months of age with others seeing large pens at £970 and Sisters to £840. Peter Amor again leading the Midlands Mart Movement selling 13 month Limousin Heifers to £1295. Rupert Inkpen selling strong Angus to 13 month Steers to £1310 with others £1140 and £1070.

A first outing for team Goodrest Limousin today saw serious enquiry. Yearling Steers £1510 and £1500 with others £1400, £1355 and £1295 Sisters to £1210. So as to round the first out to RFM off for WE James Farming a good show of Store Cattle selling to £1460 for 4 Limousin Steers 11-12 months others £1430 and £1250. Simmentals well represented by Messrs Vernon with 14 month Steers to £1245 and 10 month to £1145.

Nice to see Robert Leach using the Store Cattle Sales to sell his Shorthorn Steers at £1035 13 months of age. Heifers from Woods Farm Meriden saw Simmentals 14-16 months take £1285 and £1150. Holstein Steers from Bumble Bee Farms sold £985. Dairy men carried on reaping rewards WAC Gilbert of Lutterworth selling 15 month Steers to £1100 and £1025 with Angus Heifers £990 - £950 16 months. Messrs Mallabers good run then seeing a good enquiry for strength starting at £1245 for Shorthorns 13 -15 months and £1190 whilst Sisters took £1210 and a 18 month Shaped Shorthorn Heifer £1415. Parry Walters selling the Steers in to concentrate his expert Skills on feeding Heifers for the Fat ring. 19 month old Limousin Steers seeing £1510 and £1550 for 22 months. Others £1410 and £1340. Qualty then from Jane Gilbert selling Blue Steers 19 months to £1800 with Limousin £1640. £1620 and Heifers to £1700 and £1620 the run of 6 avg £1670. Then the star for the day from Robert and Tom Goode of HL Goode & Son selling an Angus run of 30 to Avg £1531. Topping at £1885 for a pair 19 months with other pairs of Steers £1840, £1790, £1760 and £1690 with Heifers to £1450 and £1380.
