## SPRING LAMBS: 3157 FORWARD SQQ 234.6P/KG

Simply Outstanding!! 3157 Lambs meeting a ballistic trade returning 234.6p/ kg equivalent to 5.12p/kg deadweight. Export orders in full flow for the Quarbani festival and buyers desperate to fill orders. Trade would have been perhaps 240p/kg if not for the high number of lambs over 44.5kg carrying too much cover to Export. In summary a busting trade with buyers seemingly with endless orders on the day. Ram Lambs and best export lambs holding a premium but on the day a bonanza for the O grade lambs with the festival demanding numbers in any form. In the Euro section a top of 306p/kg for overnight Beltex for Sorefinger Farms at 36kg ahead of S Collie at 282p/kg on two occasions. W Haynes & Son showed 40.5kg to 267p/kg with R F Staveley Ltd 266p/kg and 263p/kg at 38kg. David Wadland showed finish and width to take 259p/kg at 39kg for Beltex and D W Gurney & Son 45.5kg to 255p/kg. Numbers adding up throughout today with for example AJ & JM Young, Aylesbury selling 201 lambs to avg 244p/kg. Heavies well supported throughout topping at 248p/kg for Hillside Farm ahead of a pen full of 48kg at 244p/kg from L Swerling, Thame. W B Wrench 48kg to 240p/kg and E J Taylor & Son 50kg to 240p/kg. In the lump a top for Export weights to 45.5kg to £116 for DW Gurney & Son, Milton Keynes. 36kg to £110 from the Kent traveling salesmen and 45kg Ram Lambs to £110 for 45kg from B C Burton. Pete Incley, Watford saw £109.50 at 44kg and W Haynes £108 at 40kg. Heavies short across the country and topping today for weekly Supporters FJ Tombs & Son with 54kg to £127 whilst LA & VS Evans, Aylesbury saw £125 at 53kg and Humphrey Livestock £122 at 53kf. Messrs McCurdie, Wrench, Leach, Taylor and Tombs again hitting £120.
