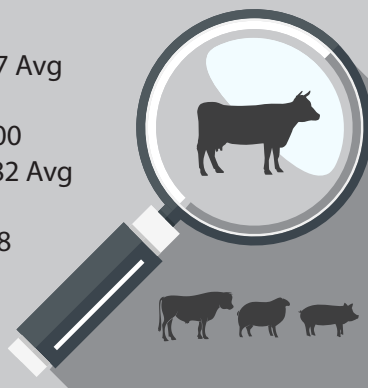

Despite a Bank Holiday yarding 1480 Hoggs still found, as is the way at this point of the season a cross of meat and also runs of Hoggs that people have lost patience with. Meat today travelling from all around with a variety of Derbyshire Vendors, Staffordshire, Bedfordshire, Essex and Caerphilly. Best Export Hoggs a serious trade as where the weighted meat. Lacking meat though and a step back of 30p/kg. Top today dominated by P & C Bromwich down from Oakham selling 40kg to 490p/kg for Beltex with others 476p/kg. PJ Incley 40.5kg at 469p/kg and Poplar Faming 444p/kg at 45kg. Shape and meat 420p/kg plus with leaner Export Hoggs 380-400p/kg and middleweight upwards lacking meat 360p/kg mark. Weighted Hoggs still a trade and selling to 465p/kg at 46kg for P & C Bromwich whom also sold 49.5kg at 439p/kg. with JM Grace 0kg at 436p/kg. Leaner heavy weights now much harder to sell. In the lump Export Hoggs to £204 at 45.5kg for the Bromwich family with Poplar Farming 45kg at £200 and 40kg £196. P Incley 40.5kg at £190. Weight totting up to £238 at 60kg from M Haddon with £234 P & C Bromwich with J Barnett £230. Messrs Edmunds up from Caerphilly to take £228.50 at 68kg. Hoggs still hanging in there and we now look to the Festival.

SPRING LAMBS: 547 FORWARD SQQ 411P/KG AVG £168



A poor show of Lambs on the whole for Bank Holiday today meeting a continued selective trade. Thankfully though the Live ring has found its level and not continued to fall as has the deadweight quote. Export and City Lambs in good demand regularly selling 430p/kg plus. Lean Handy weights 415-430p/kg throughout, harder to sell though lambs over 42kg with these processing lambs still trumped by Hoggs and Hoggs comparatively dearer. They can sell what they can sell. Meat Export and City Lambs still a serious trade and equal to £9 plus. Top ppk today E Brain & Son with fresh little 36kg at 467p/kg equal with JM Grace. S & GM Wright also selling Texel with a little shape to 463p/kg. S & C Farming down from Stafford also 460p/kg.

The weather taking hold of the lambs and some lacking finish today weight as discussed harder to sell with 43kg up at a 10p/kg disadvantage like for like up to 46kg and then weight further discounted for weight over and above. In the lump handy weight Lambs selling to £183 at 44kg for R Deacon with E Glover 43kg to £182 and J Jeyes £181 for 44kg. E Brain & Son 41kg at £180. Overall a top of £200 for 53kg for RAE Wilson & Son with R Deacon 52kg at £197 and B & G Hinton 49.5kg at £190. MM Clarke & Son 50kg to £190. We await the end of the Hoggs which is likely to coincide with the end of Quarbani this year! The changeable weather washing meat off lambs and vendors are politely asked to draw lambs on meat not just to weight. With trade still well in front of historical rates, end users evermore choosy.
