Leedham and Laban Partners also clearing up some small but meat Hogs at 331p/kg. Export Weights the flavour of the day though selling to 318p/kg at 38kg from W B Wrench. Yet again a record Entry for this period of the year as numbers continue to flow to Stoneleigh Park from all surrounding Counties and much further afield.

A full ringside of buyers results in a report that sees best bred and young Cattle at new highs whilst heavier and aged Cattle perhaps £50 back on the week.

Starting with Incalf Cows, Avon Blue sold 16 forward Cows to a top of £1600 with others £1400. Bulls saw 10 month Limousin from Messrs Semple to £1100.

Into the younger Cattle and Wolverton Farms a great show to see 7 month old Simmental Steers to £930. Simmental Heifers from Woods Farm saw £900 at 10 months.

Messrs Goodrest Limousin next in with a regular team of Disciples travelling to buy these well bred run. Topping at £1200 for Limousin Steers 11 months of age sisters saw £1165, not bad for the last of this Springs draw. Messrs Yeo next in with a run of 62 Suckler bred Cattle off Exmoor. Buyers very keen for these improving Cattle and 11 month Charolais Steers topped at £1085 and £1065 with South Devons £960 and sisters £930. JHB Hart sold Blonde Heifers to £1155 and £1125 14 months of age. JA & S Wrench next with Limousin Steers 9 months to £1200, 10 months to £1205 and 8 months £1200 others £1170 and £1115 and an older 16 month Steer £1250. A super super run of quality then from E W Blood & Sons Ltd down from Leicestershire to see yearlings top at £1535, £1475, £1460, £1410, £1350 and £1310 with Heifers to £1220, £1120 and £1115. A super run of Cattle throughout!

JK Smith & Son with the annual Spring Consignment saw Beef Shorthorn Steers to £1135 and £1185 at 11 months with Simmentals to £1195 and £1090 at the same age. Limousin Heifers saw £1030, £970 and £915. Gloucestershire represented by Messrs Hart selling to £990 for Blonde Steers 11 months with Limousin 11 months £960.

S Brodie then showing yearling strength to take Limousin to £1350 and £1145. R V Tomlinson then visiting down from Stoke Golding to take Charolais Heifers 11 months to £900. Angus saw traditional from R Inkpen to £925 at yearlings before Messrs Vernon sold Simmentals to £1100 at 12 months and sisters £925. P J Incley across from Northampton saw Limousin Steers £1195, £1190 and £1150 for Simmentals 14 months. Simmentals 12 to 15 months from P & F Baker sold to £1205 with others £1190.

First time vendors P Milner sold strength with Limousin Steers to £1440 for a trio 15 months and 5 others to £1200. King of the Bucket feeders next Robert Burman saw £1640 15 month old Blues with Heifers £1400 and £1360. Leicester based R L Root & Son next selling Angus 17 months to £1370 and £1290. Whilst Bucket reared from JD Weaver, Shipston on Stour saw Angus Heifers to £1000 16 months and Blues £990. Next Banbury based Messrs Taylor selling Simmental Steers 17-19m Steers to £1290 and Stabalisers £1165. Simmental Sisters £1120. P & F Bakers older section then saw £1520 for Simmental Steers 17 months with others £1300.

Terry Preston with strength then to sell Blue Steers 18 months to £1570 and £1500 with sisters £1470. Kirsty Badger kicked off with home bred Limousin Steers 15 months at £1600 others £1425 £1415 and £1400 whilst sisters made £1400. Then on to Bucket Blues selling to £1245, £1200 and Heifers £1220. John Peebles next man with quality to see 18 month Heifers to £1315, £1310 and £1305 whilst Blues to £1355 and £1310. Team Jackson then from Market Bosworth saw Blues 19 months £1395 with others £1385 and Blue Heifers £1385.
