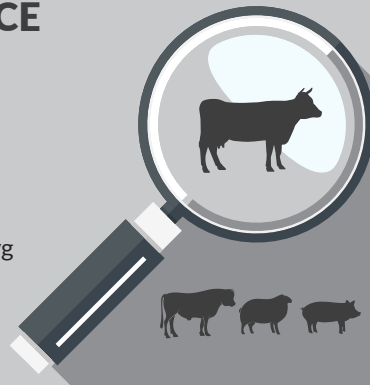

A full show report can be found herewith. More lambs today and more meat. Deadweights dropping the price but a full ring of buyers produced an Sqq of 285. Skewed of course with the inclusion of the show but prior to starting the show and Sqq of 272 for the commercials with the only hard commodity to get away being lean Export weight lambs needing finish and now becoming a very bad percenting commodity as we end the lamb season. Meat export weights almost all exclusively 280 to 320p/kg with the only discounted section being 43 to 45kg that struggled for price advantage with weight. Heavy lambs 260 plus throughout with only lean 260-265p/kg and of course the super heavies. Show lambs a smart showing if not the quality of usual years. Buyers galore as Butchers shops travelled from the north to secure some quality resulting in a white hot Show lamb trade with plenty 400p/kg plus topped by the New Champions the Geary Family when taking 800p/kg for heavy weight Beltex. These lambs now winging their way to Kuwait City for a Christmas Party!!

Meat remains the key and bellies now need clipping. Dirty lambs cannot be presented with Trading Standards and FSA now making formal complaints and driving for compulsory belly clipping as dictated in northern Markets.
