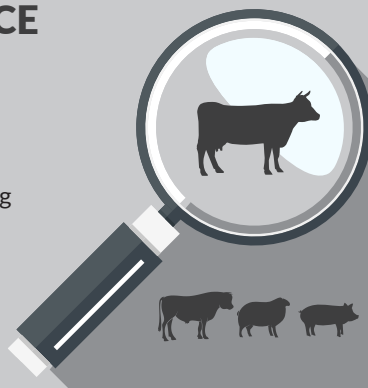

Lambs; A fair entry for a Bank Holiday and a trade at 267p/kg a very fair return on a day when Deadweights quoted only £5.30 for Tuesday Kill. Meat remains a big issue here with many Lambs undercooked and some now going to be fed. Meat Lambs a large premium throughout and plenty towards the Magical 300p/kg. Shape a nice premium throughout topping at 326p/kg at 38kg for Allen & Partners with Julain White 324p/kg and 43.5kg from DS & LA Wadland to 322p/kg. Weight the easiest sold all day as the Export trade continues to falter with orders very slow on the Continent. Topping at 309p/kg for 48.5kg DS & LA Wadland whom also sold 50.5kg to 297p/kg with P East 48.5kg to 293p/kg. Meat so much easier to sell and far too many Lambs forward that are barely good Stores. Export meat regularly 270-280p/kg with lean undershot Export weights 250 – 265p/kg throughout.

The all in Avg £114.50 a nice return for the time of year and the number of light lambs rushed along for the time of year. In the Lump Export Lambs topping at £140 for 45.5kg from M Woodward with G L Woodard 44.5kg to £134 and 44.5kg at £131. Messrs Wadland to £130 at 45kg. Overall weight well chased selling to £162 at 68kg for LA & VS Evans, Thame with Messrs KT & SR Taylor 62kg to £158. MJ Woodard 48kg to £152 and Messrs Wadland £150 twice at 48.5 and 50kg.

Trade at the Sales counter remains hard with the Export depressed by a wealth of lean Lambs Nationally on Supply. Meat a premium and we very much want and need. Feeding is very much a worthwhile premium with regularly a £20 plus premium on fed Lambs.

NCM Aged Ewes to £155 from Hedges and Kerwood. Then on to the Double Theaves which set the Tone for the day with the Eales Dispersal seeing Texel x to £195 and £172 whilst Messrs Jones £178.

On into the Theaves and some real demand for White Face Sheep as has been witnessed throughout the Season.
