

It is reiterated that there will be an influx of buyers in the new year to place lambs on fields of root crops currently untouched. We need larger entries of short and long keep lambs going forward.

FORWARD SQQ 252P/KG 🔥🔥🔥

ALL LAMBS IN AVG £106!!!!!!

A Freezing Winters day warmed by the hottest of trades! To see is to believe!! A typical Christmas period yarding with numbers hard to find as producers spent quality relaxing time with their families content with the fact that the deal completed by Boris, seemingly had little adverse effect to their trade at first glance. Those that did show the 1200 or so lambs rewarded by an unexpected flying trade with all weights buoyed by the small window of opportunity to process lamb before the next holiday highlight. An Sqq of 252p/kg included Swaledales, Welsh and in general an average yarding of lambs. Trade simply flying due to National Supply and Demand forces resulting in a deadweight equivalent of 530p/dwkg and a per head avg of £106!!

Export weights remained the order of the day albeit Shape and finish holding a bonus but not as pronounced as usual. Today lambs had to be bought at all costs. Top in the Euro weights saw 318p/kg at 44kg from B C Burton with shape and weight whilst Bailey & Moore sold 38kg to 311p/kg and BJ & IS Wain small but perfectly formed Beltex to 311p/kg at 31.5kg. First in the ring today Chiltern Beltex up from the flood plains of Oxfordshire saw 39kg to 308p/kg whilst another loyal traveller saw MK & SM Gray make 41kg to 300p/kg. 300p/kg also taken at 33kg and 40kg from Chiltern Beltex and 296p/kg at 40.5kg again from Messrs Gray and O Black down from Melton Mowbray. In the heavies shape rewarded throughout selling to 266p/kg at 46.5kg from AEJ & FJ Claridge, Bucks with classy finished Texels. BJ & IS Wain saw Beltex to 46kg at 264p/kg and JK Smith and Sons started their run of 202 lambs with a pen of proper Charolais fed meat at 45.5kg 259p/kg. RFS, Suffolk saw real Scotch Half-Breds to 257p/kg at 46kg and Master Amor 49.5kg to 253p/kg.

Returns today perhaps unseen in January before and topping the day and Export weight section was weekly vendor BC Burton with 44kg taking a whopping £140 with others from the same 43.5kg to £125 whilst SLAM Farming £124.80 for 43kg Blue Texels with Humphrey Livestock £124.50 at 45kg. Heavies very reluctantly dearer but dragged up by the massive trade for all others seeing £131 at 52kg from Amorise Farming Ltd with BJ & IS Wain 50kg to £126 and others 49.5kg to £125.

The best of Christmas gifts. Unsustainable in the long run but very welcome. Again the live ring reacting as only it can and our policy of selling to end users not guns to hire continuing to pay dividends.


