#### **CATTLE:34 Forward**

PRIME CATTLE: 25 HEAD

A disappointing entry for numbers was on offer to a large ring of buyers with several new faces present. Trade would be dearer on the week with everything in demand, the entry benefitted from stars in every category and demand outstripped supply.

#### **BULLS:10 HEAD**

Excellent numbers forward, and with buyers for everything, all bulls were sold to vendors satisfaction. Woods Farm topped the sale at 188p for a Simmental which grossed £1355.48, followed by a well fed Ayrshire from Messrs Hall which realised £1200. Black-whites sold to £1027.12 from G. Ratcliffe.

#### STEERS: 8 HEAD

A poor entry for numbers, saw demand strong throughout with numbers woefully short of buyers needs. A super heavyweight Limousin from Messrs Baylis topped the section at 210p, grossing £1596.00, other continentals sold to 196p from the Cross Family.

#### **HEIFERS: 7 HEAD**

Simply a flying trade for all types, topping the section and sale was a super Limousin at 212p from Martin Baylis and Family, who sold others to 195p. The highlight of the section was the trade experienced for heavy, heavyweights which regularly sold in the high 180's. Top price per head was £1348.71 for a super heavy Charolais from Lester Smith who sold others to £1336.23 and £1317.60.

#### OTM's and Overage: 9 HEAD

A tremendous show for quality and meat, all buyers back and firing and everything wanted, topping the section was a Charolais from Lester Smith weighing 1040 Kilo's and making 148p realising £1539.20. Limousin's from Richard Ellis sold to 147p and 140p and his load averaging £1110 per head. Native breeds sold to 130p and realised £920.40 from Ian Birden, perhaps the trade of the day was a Red Poll at 126p grossing £599.76.

#### Prime Hoggs: 2050 Forward SQQ 210p/kg

An Sqq of 210p/kg across 2050 a consequence of new faces at ringside today all trying to make themselves heard. In truth an unsustainable SQQ and trade when compared to the Exchange rate and level of trade on the Continent and more easily to understand, how dear the Hogg trade compares to the deadweight offering!

That said some super lambs at the top with Euro lambs selling to 247, 246 and 245p/kg from Pete Batchelor with others 243p/kg and 242p/kg from D Gurney at 39kg and B C Burton 240p/kg for 40.5kg and 39kg with 239p/kg from John Elkington at 35kg and 237p/kg for 38kg from A T Ivory & Son all with meated finished Hoggs. PPK for heavies saw a top of 233p/kg at 47kg from R Webb, Water Stratford whilst W B Wrench saw 46kg 217p/kg with Messrs Webb also 46kg to 216p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs topping out at £109.50 for 45kg from P Batchelor with £99.50 for W B Wrench at 43kg and 45kg from R Williams, Hereford. Overall a yarding dominated by weight and topped at 65kg from B C Burton. Messrs Cook, Bristol showed 108 heavies to top at £117 for 69.5kg with others 64kg too £116.

Trade today out of line and likely that in current climates it will drop swiftly week.
