

More meat on display and many more needed. We don't just need the superstars we need good honest well fed meat throughout with buyers stood at ringside keen to fill orders. Aged Cattle on fire and vendors should take advantage.

Steers:

Some real finish about today seeing R Grades around the 240p/kg with better end R Grades to 256.5p/kg. U- to 265p/kg from Pete Jarrom whilst weighted shape from the Tustians today saw heavies at 280p/kg from Ralph Tustian and a real sort 288p/kg. O+ grade Steers topping out at 234p/kg but all over 228p/kg. Top gross today a massive £2114 from Ralph Tustian whom also sold to £1960. N Foster showing his usual quality at £1816 and Angus from J Windridge saw £1726.

Heifers:

A real grateful ring of buyers acknowledging better fed cattle. Medium weights topping at 276p/kg for F Hodgkin with U- and real feeding from D Ofield saw 270.5p/kg. Best end R/U- from J Peebles and J D Stephens 270p/kg. R Grades regularly 245p/kg to 255p/kg dependent on feeding and O+ Grades into the 240p/kg mark. Top gross £1765 to F Hodgkin with A Sabin back with bucket fed calves done very well to £1703. Hodgkin £1662 and Peebles £1610.

Bulls

A show of the Natives today saw great demand. Heavyweight Angus Bulls from Hull Farms sold at 774kg and 234p/kg with others 228p/kg for heavies from Hull and lights from Tacy. Top gross £1812 from Hull Farms.

OTM:s

Real meat in this section today seeing some records set for the section with a 32 month heifer from Henry Tustian taking £2008!!!!! This heifer being a super E Grade Heifer that sadly didn't hold found great favour from buyers at 286p/kg. Meat R Grades saw Colban Ltd, Oxford 226 and 225p/kg for medium weight heifers whilst weighted heifers from D Ofield saw 220p/kg at 38 months old. Steers to 224p/kg twice at 35months from D Powers returning £1340.

Cows;

Sadly 10 booked in and didn't arrive which was a massive shame with so many buyers wanting Cows. Meat a real commodity and best Cows chased, R Grades 180p/kg plus topping at 228p/kg for a young Cow from JA & S Wrench with Limousin whilst a 7 year old from the same saw 214p/kg. J Windridge & Son sold Simmentals at 180.5p/kg whilst natives 176p/kg from P Jarrom. Parlour Cows to 149p/kg from Seymour -Smith & Sons. Top gross £1588 from JA & S Wrench with others £1414. Dairies to £1230.

Stock Bulls;

Super Angus Stock Bulls from Ed Hull saw the four deviate from 166p/kg to 176p/kg seeing very heavy Bulls 5 years old to £2188 and £2092.

2400 Hoggs forward today to meet a most selective trade with a real fast trade for export weight Hoggs 42kg and under and a much harder trade on mid-weights and heavies. Basically a massive oversupply nationally of heavy weights and fat Hoggs. Export weights so dear today though that it makes the SQQ 278p/kg despite the slow in trade for 43 to 45.5kg. Plenty of Export 37kg to 41kg today past 300p/ kg. Mid weights harder to sell and heavies out in massive supply. The real problem seems to be that unlike other years Exporters are yet unable to send heavier bodies abroad with Europeans only willing to take Export weight bodies. In other years this weight limit has raised in line with the growth of the average Hogg. This year seemingly not. Those with the goods to meet demand today receiving a very swift trade. Real shape at 34kg from M & C Morris saw 341 p/kg before D W Gurney started a good run with Beltex at 38.5kg to 340p/kg with M & C Morris to 39kg at 331p/kg and D W Gurney & Son 41kg to 326p/kg. NF & K Redfern good meat at 43kg to 321p/kg. N Wallington 38.5kg to 317p/kg and D Gurney 316p/kg at 42.5kg. In the heavies a stronger trade seen for best ends with real shape from Nigel and Kerry Redfern 48kg to 298p/kg and 46kg to 295p/kg from D W Gurney & Son who also sold 48.5kg to 285p/kg. In the lump Export weights totting up at rates that made a mockery of the weighted Hoggs. Top saw 43kg from the Redfern family at £138 with 44.5kg from BJ & IS Wain to £138 at 44.5kg. Messrs Gurney sold 42.5kg to £134.50 and 45.5kg to £134.50. Heavies a hard sell all day but the best saw £150.50 from HL Goode & Sons at 79kg with PF Edwards 66kg to £145 and Redferns 48kg shape at £143. R H Maycock & Sons, Aylesbury saw 68kg to £141 and T A Wrench, and JT Jeyes & Son £140. Next week vendors are encouraged to think about what they are marketing. The current trade is for Export Hoggs and so best to suit sales to the same. Perhaps the heavies may need to be chanced for another few weeks.


