Show day and a separate Report can be found here within. A smaller yarding than expected for the Commercials and in all truth the single worst show we have ever witnessed on these Shores. Lack of finish in the majority of the lambs with the weather seemingly washing them free of meat. Despite this new buyers in attendance and trade a real rip roaring trade with Export bottom end all trading around 260p/kg with better end often 280p/kg to 300p/kg. Commercial Lambs topping at 323p/kg for 40kg for C Angus and 316p/kg for 40.5kg from B C Burton. 45.5kg from B Burton and Poulson & Co both selling to 295p/kg. Heavy lambs again the main draws with these the best meat on show throughout. Super quality at 49kg saw 318p/kg from BJ & IS Wain with 47kg from S Leedham to 311p/kg and 47.5kg from Messrs Wain at 301p/kg. In the lump Export lambs to 45.5kg to £134 for Poulson & Co and B Burton. Last man in P Edwards sold 45kg to £130 with C Angus £129. Heavies topping at £180 for 62kg from Poulson & Co with Philly Batchelor 68kg to £176 and P Edwards 62kg at £173. Meat the key with the Kill percentages very low on lean lambs as a result of the year.
