In the Euros today 100 lambs selling over 195p/kg and topping at 227p/kg for smart Beltex from Pete Batchelor for 40.5kg with 43.5kg at 215p/kg from the same home. Meated 30kg from Frankie Badger to 207p/kg and J B Elkington 204p/kg at 40.5kg. In the heavies a top ppk of 202p/kg for a pen of super Beltex from Pete Batchelor at 50kg ahead of Chris Clayton at 191p/kg for 46kg and David Fountain at 189p/kg for 46kg. In the lump Euro lambs coming out well at £93.50 for 43.5kg from Pete Batchelor with 40.5kg at £92. David Fountain £90 for 45kg and James Grindal £87.50 for 45kg. Overall heavies topped at £103 for Ted Mawby with 63kg Texels whilst 50kg from P Batchelor £101 and £100 for Chris Clayton at 63kg and 70kg from Charles Harding. A very swift trade but perhaps a little too dear for sustainability.

The Second Martinmas Store Cattle Fair attracted a smaller entry of stores, seeing a slight dip in trade from the first sale, but also a dip in quality. Starting with a few breeding cattle, which saw TH Morris and Sons sell a 2006 Simmental cow, with a Simmental Heifer calf to £1270, with G&V Beech reaching £1050 with a 2012 Hereford Stock Bull. On into the store cattle where JC Bostock sold 4 month old Pure Charolais Bulls to £600, while sisters from the same home realized £650. Older by 2 months saw Simmental x Steers to £680 from D & GM Wright. AJ Robinson was rewarded for the trip from Peterborough seeing £700 for Saler x Steers at 8 months of age. Moving on through the sale saw Peter Amor sell a marvelous British Blue x Heifer to £800 at nearly 7 months of age, with Limousin x from the same home to £830 at a similar age. On through the ages saw TH Morris selling 18 month Pedigree Simmental Heifers to £910, while G&V Beech sold the sons to their bull to £1015 at 18 month. Mick Lord made his first outing of the autumn to sell Limousin x Steers to £820 also at 18 months. Another shift up the ages saw a consignment from the late P Gibbs, topping to £1010 with a Blonde x Steer at 20 months, while the Heifers from the same home settled to £980 at 22 months for cattle small for age. Following on to the annual draft from RAJ & D Hopkins which saw Charolais x Steers to a storming £1220 at 20 months, while the sisters topped at £860 at 22 months. H Lawton saw his Pure Bred South Devon steers to £930, with the pen full averaging £920, before showing bucket calves to £760 for 18 month Simmental x Heifers. Stuart Cartwright saw Hereford x Steers to £1090 at 25 months, with homebred Blonde x Steers to £1000 at 19 months. B L Lay sold framey Limousin x Steers to £1040 at 19 months before WJS Turner's consignment of 25 topped at £1035 for a 25 month Limousin x steer, with heifers from the same home to £920 at 23 months. RL Root & Son sold well fed Simmental x Steers to £1195 at 23 months, with Angus x Heifers to £955 from the same home, before a second consignment from GM & LD Robson saw Shorthorn Steers to £1095 at 21 months. 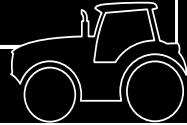
