Trade still very buoyant at 296p/kg but obviously markedly back on the week as was to be predicted with last weeks trading simply unsustainable and numbers in the north and east coming forwards as Landlords require ground back ready to Spring Drill a few weeks ahead of us. Meat the key again and best end remain in demand. Top today from VJ Roots saw 43kg at 367p/kg for Beltex before M & C Morris 350p/kg to 361p/kg for Beltex pens 43,44 and 45kg. Plenty of meat over 320p/kg. First cross meat 290 – 300p/kg with lean under done 270p/kg mark. Heavies topping at 53kg to 342p/kg from M J Woodward with V J Roots 47.5kg at 339p/kg and L C Threadgold 46kg to 326p/kg. Meat still all over 300p/kg. but over heavies dropping quickly trading 270p/kg mark. In the lump Export Hoggs to £160 at 45kg from M & C Morris with VJ Roots 43kg to £158 with 45.5kg to £156. Top of the tree this week £181 for 53kg Beltex for MJ Woodward with R Kellett 69kg at £181. K Crabtree 63kg to £180 and 73kg from JK Smith and Son £180.
