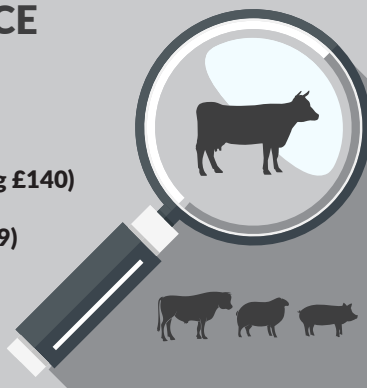

Best Lambs would actually be dearer on the week but quality very sparce throughout and Lambs in general really lacking finish and quality. An SQQ of 341p/kg though in line. Best Lambs though a massive premium seeing 421p/kg and 417p/kg at 38kg from P Cobley, Leicester with 39kg at 409p/kg and others 408p/kg. D & GM Wright 39kg at 396p/kg and E Brain & Sons Ltd 40kg at 386p/kg. Meat Export weights mainly all 350p/kg with Lambs over 43kg a harder sell throughout with Hoggs still the preferred Commodity on the Continent and the Cutting Rooms. Heavy Lambs topping at 354p/kg at 48kg from C R Hill with FJ Tombs & Son 47.5kg to 331p/kg. Quality meat and finish highly rewarded with meat Export Lambs trading 350-400p/kg and second rate Export Lambs 330p/kg to 350p/kg. IN the lump Export weights to £160 at 38kg from P Cobley who also sold 39kg to £159. MM Clarke & Sons with fully fed Lambs saw £156 at 43kg and BJ & IS Wain 44kg to £155 equal with Messrs Tombs. Nice fresh Lambs from E Brain & Sons Ltd 40kg to £154.50. Overall a top of £170 for C R Hill with proper meated Lambs at 48kg and CH Evans & Son 51kg to £168. £167 for FJ Tombs and £165 for 50kg from N Faulconbridge & Son.

Lambs really not the bloom that is expected at this time of year with last years weather conditions now hitting home and quality in general not equal to the 'norm' for the time of year. Hoggs seemingly still the vogue and perhaps as these dry Lambs will have a wider audience.
