PRIME CATTLE:55 HEAD

A slightly reduced entry was on offer to another good company of buyers with all the butchers in attendance. Trade was variable with the best sharper and cattle showing the weather easier on the week.

BULLS:2 HEAD

A small entry saw shorthorns sell to £966.40 from Roger and Tom Elliott, with others to 151p from the same.

STEERS:22 HEAD

A variable entry for quality and breeds saw demand from ringside for all types with native breeds meeting the best demand from butchers and wholesalers alike. The section was topped by Roger and Tom Elliott with a heavyweight Saler-Cross at 209p, this run of Saler and Shorthorn's averaged 20 Ivan and John Tivey sold home bred Angus's to £1250.38.

HEIFERS:22 HEAD

A good entry met excellent demand from the butchers and wholesaler at ringside and proved short of requirements. Brian Smith fetched a marvellous run of heifers and was rewarded when a superb Heavyweight Limousin topped the section and sale at 226p, others from the run sold to 216 and 214 for Charolais. Pete Smith sold Limousin's to 214p, and Simon Wright in dad's absence sold homebred Angus's to 211p. Heavyweight's topped at £1308.54 from Red House Farm, and £1305.40 from Green Wicket Farm.

OTM's and Over-age:9 HEAD

An entry dominated by a marvellous run of Simmental Cows from H.G.Heath and Sons, which sold to 136p twice and averaged 125.9p overall. Top price per head was £1041.25 for the pen leader from Messrs Heath, who sold others to £993.75. As ever more are needed to supply the growing demand from ringside.

PRIME LAMBS: Forward SQQ 178p/kg

A marked decrease in numbers as farmers catch up with fed lambs and a trade of 178p/kg responding to a national slow in numbers. Handy weight lambs regularly heading past 3.90p/kg deadweight equivalent. Lambs over 44kg harder to sell with a wealth of lambs 44 to 50kg now marketed and at saturation point. Export lambs the opposite and easily sold to an improved trade with 150 lambs selling over 190p/kg. In the Euro section a top 209p/kg for 37kg from S T Phillips with Rouge shape ahead of R Richins, 44kg 207p/kg for Beltex. Fed lambs from A N Calcott 204p/kg at 41.5kg and 41kg 202p/kg with Woody the Pecker showing grass lambs 200p/kg at 40kg. Heavies saw a top of 206p/kg for 47kg from Showell Farms. SLAM Blue Texels showed 47kg to 191p/kg with Page Bros first in the draw to see 189p/ kg at 48.5kg. In the lump Euro Lambs topping out at £91 for 44kg from R Richins with G L Woodard 45kg to £89.50 and Page Bros 44kg to £88. Three figures about reached today seeing J K Smith & Son at £100 for 69kg with F J Tombs 66kg to £99.50 and Showell Farms 47kg to £97. Meat and spec lambs in demand but too many mid weight lambs finding a limited user. Trade should be monitored this week as the welcome lift has no clear backing as to why it may be sustainable.
