## **CATTLE: 64 FORWARD**



A shortage in numbers but a flying trade throughout as Wholesalers feel the pinch of Cattle shortages. Nice runs of travelled cattle with meat well received but more finish needed on the whole.

#### Steers:

Super quality at the top end with U= to 263.5p/kg from G R Fountaine & Son whilst a lovely run of Sussex x Limousin Steers from Passmore Brothers really ticked the boxes with top end R Grades taking 241p, 240p, 237.5p and 233p/kg O+ cattle on fire as long as finished with very little discount selling to 227p/kg. In the lump a top of £1803 to Messrs G Fountaine & Son with O Grades to £1549 from Hull Farms and Sussex to £1512 from Passmore Bros purchased By Hartshead Meats, Manchester.

#### Heifers;

Not the show we have become used too but that said where the quality of Confirmation fell the level of feeding made up for it with properly Finished R Grades on parade. Top 255p/kg at U- from F Hogkin with nice meat R Grades at 248p/kg from Messrs Fountaine & Son. Hodgkin 243p/kg and Jarrom 239.5p/kg. O+ Grades to 230 and 225p/kg from I R Sharlot. Top gross £1576 to F Hodgkin who saw others at £1497. Bucket reared from I R Sharlot £1458. More more needed as Buyers bid freely and all very much wanting to drive this Centre forwards.

#### Bulls;

Weight no issue as so long as finish is present. Simmentals at 830kg taking £1884 for C H Evans & Son.

#### Cows;

Demand remains constant on the Cows and Buyers ready eagerly to chase meat. Top end weight perhaps a little steadier as last weeks figures scare Salesmen but that said still everyone needing Cows just hoping they come cheaper. Herefords today to 185p/kg and 180p/kg from DJ Hull & Partners who sold genuine weighted old girls to 167p/kg and 158p/kg. Top Cow gross £1346 and £1325 from D J Hull Farms, Essex and more Cows over £1200 then under today. A heavy Angus Stock Bull seeing 131p/kg and £1570 from R Ellis.

SPRING LAMBS:1218 FORWARD SOO 244P/KG AVG £103 99

The end of last week signalling the beginning of a slip and as a result a tailored yarding today of 1250 Lambs, which in truth showed a real lack of quality on avg, met a trade that completely blitzed all others, seeing 244p/kg SQQ and avg £103. In truth a sale that saw the first 60% selling well towards a 250p/kg avg and then pulling back drastically as reports of 220p/kg purchase prices elsewhere filtered through. Top price though for quality seeing D Refern, Derby sell 40kg to 305p/kg whilst MM Clarke & Son showed real shape at 37kg to 297p/kg with overnight Texels 44.5kg to 285p/kg from Midland Environmental and Messrs Redfern then keeping up a good run at 280p/kg for 41kg. Heavies a harder sell as home trade slows but seeing 49kg to 271p/g from Midland Environmental who also sold 48kg to 263p/kg and G L Woodard, Banbury 257p/kg. In the lump Export Lambs topping out at £127 for 44.5kg from Midland Environmental, Northampton who sold the same at £121. D Redfern, Derby sold to £122 for 40kg and Bailey & Moore, Leicestershire 43kg to £120.50. Overall a top of £134 and £133 from Midland Environmental at 49kg with MJ Martin 57kg to £132, J Herod 56kg £131 and J & B Hinton, Brackley 54kg to £127.50.

Trade historically wobbling during the beginning of August as France takes a prolonged Holiday and the Home trade steadies as School Holidays commence and people run for the Coast. Vendors should be aware that national kills are well ahead and should not panic sell but instead make sure that Lambs are fully fit before drawing with lightweights set to steady at this time of year in any case.

Top today of £170 to Joseph Morris with Charolais Ewes whilst Passmore Brothers saw Texels to £154 and S Wise £149. Greenfields of Twycross £146.50, £146 and £142.50 whilst RFS sold Texel Rams to £142. Many strong Texels over £140. Suffolks today not as strong as we have seen but selling upto £136.50 from GA Royans & Son with £132 for C Barnwell and BF Humphrey & Sons most trading £120 mark. Mules back on the week understandably but still topping at £125.50 from Hyde Lane Farms with RCW Turney £124 and C W Webb & Partners £121. Fat now discounted as the Festival becomes a memory only. Lean Ewes also harder to cash as the North high grounds pull down Hill sheep at speed to meet the Lean Ewe demand.

# FRIDAY 30TH JULY BREEDING SHEEP FAIR

The annual Early Sheep sale saw a yarding equal to last years in numbers with new vendors coming forward to fill the gap left by those whom chose to Kill Ewe Hoggs in the Season. A mixed yarding in quality with some real strength in the top few % of Sheep but on the whole a drop in quality on what is usually expected in the yard. Trade meeting an absolutely full Market of Buyers resulting in a Fair trade. Perhaps not the huge returns some expected but a trade that was fair and dealt with quality accordingly with Buyers quite rightly looking to invest in top end quality and use the better returns of 2020/2021 to upgrade the flock.

#### Aged Ewes;

Plenty of demand for Aged Ewes as Buyers look for easily calculated rates of depreciation based on the huge Cull Ewe Trade at RFM. The Annual Consignment of Aged Ewes from SF & AJ Deeming topping at £210 for FM Blue Texel Ewes with FM Suffolks from the same to £169.50 and £164.50 with others £162. A Dispersal from MJ Harris Farming saw Suffolk FM to £157.50 and £156.50 for Suffolks. Mules saw Scotch Mules FM to £130 from J Baker & Sons, Leicester. Double Theaves in short supply this year but topping at £179 for Suffolk Double Theaves from MJ Harris Farming.

#### Theaves;

On the whole Texel quality on the poor side but best end White Face Sheep still very much the demanded Commodity. Top today £300 for a pen of Pure Texel Theaves from DJ &BJ Leadbeater with proper strength and skinned sheep seeing buyers from Wales to Corwall bid for them before finding new homes in Milton Keynes. Beltex from Jonjoe Morris, as seen on Facebook saw £260, £254 and £233. Strong Texel x Theaves saw large pens from MJ Woodward at £211 with CJ Clayton selling Beltex x to £210 and others £192. Texel x from Messrs Morris £190 equal with Woodwards second pen. Strong Texe Mules to £180 from Clarke Farming Partnership. Strong clear faced Texel x generally £175 plus with quality and underdone £20-30 discounted. Cheviot Mules and Cheviot x Mules in massive demand seeing a top of £215 from CJ Clayton with Cheviot x and Cheviot Mules from Jonjoe Morris £190.

#### Suffolks;

Holding the highest number of interested onlookers seeing a trade that would show the Suffolk x in great demand with best end very well chased. Top £209 from MJ Woodward with big pens throughout just pipping Philly Batchelor whom presented her Sheep expertly to see £200.50 and £200 whilst Woodward again £199. Waddesdon Estates attracting a huge following selling to a top of £197.50 and then £197, £196,£196,£195.50,£194.50 and £190.50. I Newton & Son, Tanworth in Arden £191. £188 for Andrew Foulds and BM & LE Aries. Again a £30 discount from Avg to bottom end.

#### Mules;

A super super trade for the goods on offer. Mules notoriously hard to get ready for this fixture but those requiring Breeders in to their System early out in force today. Top £183 for Mules from Waddeson Estates all ran dry just pipping MJ Woodward at £182. The rest of the Waddesdon run trading either side of £180. Clarke Farming Partnership trading to £180 for 37.

#### Charity - The Lilly Foundation

In Total the donated Theave made an incredible £5670.
