Show day and some times this can distort the averages. For the record a very swift trade in the commercials with an SQQ of 202p/kg prior to the Show sheep and an SQQ of 209p/kg afterwards. Numbers as low as we have seen for some time with the Motorways all jammed up during the morning as well as some vendors choosing to be honest bystanders for the day. Those making up the just over 1200 lambs though receiving a real trade. Show day and our pleasure to welcome Mick Etherington of Yorkshire as a last minute stand in for our Continental Judge whom could not make the trip. Mr Etherington met a marvellous show of lambs before placing his Supreme Champion with regular Mart Vendor Pete Batchelor's pen of Heavy Show prepared Beltex lambs at 53kg selling later to 566p/kg or £300 per life to Pak Mecca Meats for there Premium Export brand Akram quality. Reserve Champion this year again to Pete Batchelor with lightweight Beltex weighing 43kg and selling to 465p/kg or £200 to Pak Mecca Meats ltd. This years YFC Champion went to Josh Geary of Milton Keynes selling 45.5kg at £175 or 385p/kg to Hilltop Farmshop, Hunningham. Thank you to all that supported the show

Outside of the prize winners a fierce trade for meat and many Vendors showing lambs with deadweight equivalence in excess of 440p/kg. Export Lambs saw a top for M & C Doody with 34kg Beltex at 265p/kg ahead of his close friend Jack Gilder, Cheltenham who showed commercial lambs to 258p/kg at 31kg whilst 36.5kg from T H Morris & Sons saw 249p/kg. In the heavies and outside of the show winners a top of 247p/kg for 49kg from D W Gurney & Son with 237p/kg for 46.5kg from Pete Batchelor who also had 48kg at 229p/kg. In the lump none show winners totted up to Export lambs at £102 for 43kg from Chiltern Beltex with Ringer Farms £101 for 41kg and Jack Gilder 45kg to £100 equal with Messrs Gurney and Claridge. Overall a top for non-prize winners £138 at 79kg from A Tarry-Smith with 73kgs to £130. £126 to Pete Batchelor at 56.5kg and £121 to Messrs Gurney at 49kg. 
