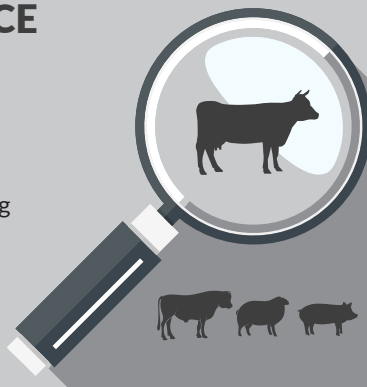

Lambs;

As is the National trend a two tier trade. Meat a very fast trade for the time of year with leaner lambs harder to fit. Numbers shorter with the 6 day rule holding many back following last Fridays Ram fair. A funny trading climate with half of today's Customers unable to compete within 10p and the others pushing on hard to secure meat. Weight very much the key with light lambs on the whole lacking finish. Best end Export weights well competed for throughout as they become a rare commodity. IM Allen Partners showed Beltex 313p/kg – 300p/kg. AR & J Collett saw fed lambs at 43kg to 302p/kg and N Walker 42kg to 300p/kg whilst D Doody 300p/kg also. Better need meat Exports 280p/kg plus with meated first cross 270-280p/kg and those lacking finish 258p/kg to 270p/kg. Weight paying and topping at 300p/kg at 50kg from R J Heckford with V R Phipps 48kg to 291p/kg and J & R Lowe 56kg to 284p/kg. HJ Spencer & Sons 57kg to 281p/kg. An all in avg of over £120 a great return once again and Export weights topping at £131 for 45kg from GR Fountaine & Son whilst AR & J Collett saw 43kg to £130 and RJ Heckford 44.5kg to £129. Weight remains the main order with Abbatoirs shipping Cuts more frequently than the Carcass trade. Top today saw 57kg to £160 from GR Fountaine & Son with J & R Lowe 59kg to £159 and HL Goode & Son 59kg to £156. AR & J Collett 61.5kg Suffolks to £155. Meat the key throughout.

A short number compared to usual Years but the strong trade Nationally has meant that most have been sold earlier in the year.

Starting with older Ewes we saw FM Suffolk from S Leedham to £180 with Texels £145 from Tillbrook Farm. Double Theaves saw Welsh Mule to £160 from P Shedd.

Theaves kicked off swiftly seeing Tillbrook Farms sell Texel Theaves to £192 and D W Gurney & Son £202. Texel x Mules saw £190 to Antelope Farm and £185 equalled by A & H Hunt. Next in the much awaited draw from Pete Batchelor with Beltex Theaves. This run topped at £360 selling to £320, £280, £260, £250, £230, £230 & £220.

Suffolks few on numbers again to £170 for Messrs A & H Hunt with Messrs Gurney & Son £180. NCM a larger show and a quality in very short Supply. Those with quality though well chased. D Burton down from Oakham saw proud headed and Mules to £201 whilst G R Hallifield sold to £196 and £190. Plenty trading £185 to £190 and only the hard done and short on size under. Ewe lambs, not a patch on the Sale of last month with most being simply female lambs and not of quality to make Breeders. Certainly no Topping Lambs forward.

The joy of buying from this section is generally the hardness of the Rams and indeed what you buy tends to look exactly the same a week after the Sale. Plenty of Quality saw Beltex and Texels top at £600 with PBatchelors Beltex in great demand and AEJ & FG Claridge competing with Garfield Stephens at £600 for top of the Tree in the Texels. P Batchelor also £580 with Messrs Claridge and AJ Smith seeing Texels £520. Any Tups with scope climbing over £500 with 18% surpassing this figure.

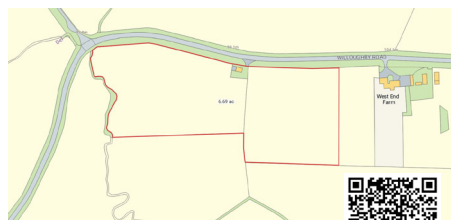
