SPRING LAMBS: 1514 FORWARD SQQ 265.5 P/KG AVG £118

The slide began in the middle of last week with a real retraction on Export demand. From last week surge for demand of stock to a much more tepid enquiry today. A wealth of lean lambs coming forward not assisting the trade at all. An SQQ of 262p/kg though at least 10p/kg ahead of most throughout the land. Export lambs trading to 315p/kg for 37.5kg from Johnjoe the Champ Morris beating Oxfords R Richins whom sold at 42kg to 312p/kg. R Burman 308p/kg at 42kg and BJ & IS Wain 43kg to 302p/kg. Meat Export weights still trading 275p/kg but lean Export weight lambs falling 250-260p/kg and feeding lambs 250p/kg mark. Weight and meat again the required commodity and well chased throughout. Messrs Claridge with weight and meat to see 46kg to 293p/kg with GR Fountaine & Son 50kg to 292p/kg and BF Humphrey & Son 51kg at 286p/kg. Humphrey Livestock 47kg at 284p/kg. An all in avg of £118 a fall of £5 back on the week but not the meat forward we had seen last week. In the lump Export weights to £144 at 45kg from R Richins with R Burman showing super meat at 44.5kg to £134 before R Richins £131 at 42 and 43kg. Overall a top today of £163 for 68kg from Hyde Lane Farms with H S Underwood & Son and C R Hill 60kg £160. R Richins £158 with J Webster, J Baker & Son and B F Humphrey & Sons all breaking £150. A much more difficult days trading but some major Export Companies not even operating nationallv.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country
