Weather simply washing meat away and as a result a short number. This atter confirmed with another face in the buying ring short on numbers as local farmers run out of meat to keep him supplied.

Trade very fast for a wet through yarding with all accounts very fast and keen to fill orders. Many more needed on the day.

Some nice breeding but now feeding is needed. Those fed lambs today at a premium. Top LG Russell & Son, Stratford heavies at 361 p/kg at 46kg with P S Bodily 358 p/kg at 47.5kg. Export lambs needing feeding in general but best end very well chased selling to 355 at 42kg from GL & AM Woodard with 40.5kg from Taylor & Son 354 p/kg. Messrs East and Wilks 350 p/kg. Export quality 320 p/kg mark with leaner first cross still 300 p/kg mark. Leaner lambs 290 p/kg mark with a trade miles ahead of deadweight comparison with most lambs £15 in front.

Heavies a real trade throughout with all corners having jobs for the commodity. Proper meat 330p/kg mark regulalry and all well finished running at 310p/kg with only the lean dipping under 300p/kg.

Export lambs totting upto £152 for 45kg from P M Wilks and £150 for P S Bodily. GL Woodard 42kg at £149 and BC Burton 45.5kg at £148.50

Weight pays and only a nats knee from £200 when making £196 for 62kg from H L Goode & Son with JF Fyfe & Nephew up from Foscot £183 at 59kg. R Burman 56kg to £181 and Messrs Goode £180.

More needed but simply put meat must be the key.




