### CATTLE: 92

#### PRIME CATTLE:74 Head

Rugby Primestock Society held there 45<sup>th</sup> Annual Christmas Show and Sale on Monday alongside the normal weekly sale where a wonderful entry of cattle were forward. Judging was in the capable hands of Mr. Richard Taylor of Owen Taylor and Sons, Derbyshire. His final line-up of the 8 haltered classes was commented on as the best seen at this centre. Taking the Supreme Championship was the winner of the Heavyweight heifer, a home-bred Limousin shown by Richard Fountaine and family. Standing reserve was the winner of the Heavyweight Steer class, a homebred Belgium-Blue cross from Frank Page and Family.

### **BULLS:2 Head**

The extra buyers at ringside saw the demand outstrip supply in this section with the pair of dairy bred bulls realising 145p and 138p from Messrs Elliott, Birch Tree Farm, as ever more are needed to supply demand.

#### STEERS:38 Head

An excellent trade for everything with demand coming from all corners of the ring, topping the section was the reserve champion, winner of the Heavyweight Steer class, a home bred Belgium-Blue from Frank Page and Family which realised 290p and purchased by the beef Judge, Mr. Richard Taylor. Messrs Davies sold lightweights to 270p for a Limousin, with Blue's to 270p from Steve Timms.

### HEIFERS:25 Head

HEIFERS DOMINATE THE CHRISTMAS SHOW AND SALE.

RICHARD FOUNTAINE REIGNS SUPREME, SELLING TO 660p A KILO.

Wonderful show of heifers, quality everywhere and after the show a first class trade was had for everything. The sale commenced with the Show Champion a Homebred, Heavyweight Red Limousin which weighted 652 kilo's and opened at 300p and quickly rose to 660p and was purchased by Cumberland Meats, to be used at beef nights in The Red Lion, Hunningham. Messrs Davies sold Limousin's to 292 and 285p, Messrs Morris sold others to 285p and 272p.

### OTM's and COWS:11 Head

A mixed entry saw several outstanding show cows to genuine worked dairy bred sucklers. Topping the sale was the 1<sup>st</sup> prize cow a blonde from market stalwart Alan Tacy which sold to 179p, which realised £1249.42. Angela Tarry-Smith sold others to £1203.60 (170p), with Steve Eales selling others to 138p for Simmentals.

Farmers; a big thank-you for supporting this section throughout the year and it was hugely pleasing to see regulars winning the majority of the prizes, and to the butchers and wholesalers who continue to shop with us, as we need both sides to make a successful and thriving market.

### PRIME LAMBS: 1569 Forward SQQ 183p/kg

A few less penned as Customers make way for the Annual Show & Sale. That said still 1300 commercial lambs sold prior to the Show to meet a harder trade but in truth an absolute awful show of under finished lambs with many lacking weight or backs returning an SQQ of 183p/kg before the Show and 187p/kg after the show. The Show as ever includes a separate report attached herewith. Our Thanks to the Judge Miss M Worsley placing her Champions a trio of 54kg Beltex from AEJ & FJ Claridge, Buckingham which went on to Sell to a Belgium Wholesaler supplied by Pak Mecca Meats Ltd at 500p/kg or £270. Reserve Champion saw Pete Batchelors 40.5kg Beltex sell to 506p/kg and £205 to Yorkshire Country Meats whilst the Young Farmers Cup went to Jon-joe Morris selling 47.5kg, Beltex at 421p/kg or £200 to Owen Taylor & Sons Ltd, Derbyshire.

Meated lambs in high demand but 38kg and less hard to shift with heavy lambs a shade less than last year. Trade harder today with buyers unwilling to commit as they report a lull pre-Chritsmas. Lambs must be fitter next week.

### **Show Sheep**

The 45<sup>th</sup> Primestock Show saw yet another large yard of Sheep presented to our Judge for the day Miss M Worsley. The addition of an extra Class this year saw an inclusion of a Class to cover any other Continentals other than those lambs Sired by Texel or Beltex. This Class was won by D W Guerney & Son, Milton Keynes. The Beltex or Texal Sired Class was once again very well attended seeing the lightweight under 43kg Class won by Pete Batchelor, Princethorpe, classy Beltex which later went on to stand Reserve Supreme Champion selling at 506p/kg for 40.5kg (£205) to Yorkshire Country Meats. These Lambs Stood Reserve to the Overall Supreme Champions from AEJ & FJ Claridge, Winslow which having won the heavy weight Texel or Beltex Class stood as exact Competition to the Champions which later sold to £270 or 500p/kg to Pak Mecca Meats for a high class Belgium Customer. Once again a hotly contested YFC class saw Ringer Farms, Hellidon take 3<sup>rd</sup> spot ahead of Joe Smith, Slapton in 2<sup>nd</sup> and this year's Champion Jon-joe Morris, Yelvertoft whom took the first prize before selling his 47.5kg Beltex to 421p/kg selling to Owen Taylor Butchers, Derbyshire. Heavy weight Natives this year provided a very competitive Class which was eventually won with Cheviots from Stimson Farming, Milton Keynes whom showed 53kg to sell at £100 to local retailers 'The Meat Rooms', Leamington Spa. The Native Lightweights this year was won by RAE Wilson, Boddington. The Novice Class this year saw some super handyweight lambs forward and eventually won by Messrs Burbage, Colly Weston selling 42kg to £98 or 233p/kg to Phil Reid, Coventry Meat Market. Cull Ewes saw the largest ever entry this year with the Continental Ewes won by Smiths of Slapton selling the trio to a wopping £230 each to Bham Halal Meats whilst the Natives Class was won by GJ & SL Gowling with Cheviots selling to £92 to Menai Meats Ltd.

#### Show Cattle

The 45<sup>th</sup> Rugby Primestock show housed possibly the best yard of Show Cattle seen within these premises in recent Memory. Our Judge this year Mr Andrew Taylor of Owen Taylor & Son, Derbyshire whom cast his expert eye across eight halter led Classes plus the Championship, together with four halter tied classes. The highly competitive Championship this year was awarded to Richard and Judy Fountaine with the Heifer that stood first in the Heavyweight Heifer class at 652kg before going on to beat Page Bros Reserve Champion which had won the Heavyweight Steer Class on its way to the Championship Class. Huge support at Ringside this year saw a Society record of 660p/kg (£4303) given for the Fountaine Families Supreme Champion by Cumberland Meat Packers, Coventry whom will be using the Beef to promote Warwickshire Beef nights through their Restaurant at the Red Lion, Hunningham. Reserve Supreme Champion and also opposite Sex to the Supreme Champion this year a marvellous heavy weight from Page Bros full of meat and weight at 786kg which sold to 290p/kg (£2279) to the Judge Richard Taylor for his Shops throughout Derbyshire.

### Home baking and Butchers classes

Last year the introduction of the Butchers and Home baking classes proved a great success and this year was expanded further with the introduction of a mince pie class.

WF Chapman Butchers of Lutterworth repeated their 2017 success with their pork sausages, whilst a delighted Kate Gunn triumphed with her pork pie. Mr John Taylor was once again judge, and was impressed with the selection of entries.
