A drop to £5 p/kgdw on the morning would have commanded a trade of 230p/kg for Export weights but thankfully nearly all Export weight meat today trading over 240p/kg showing the strength we poses around the ring here at RFM. An SQQ of 246p/kg the top nationally for the day and a testament to good meat and a ring full of buyers. Best end lambs a nice trade with Wholesalers fir for Butcher front windows. Top today 311/kg for 42.5kg from R RIchins, Oxford with Matt and Claire Morris selling 44kg at 305p/kg with Beltex from MM Clarke & Sons to 305p/kg at 40kg. R Richins with a further two pens over 300p/kg. Heavy Meat the easiest to sell throughout seeing 288p/kg at 50kg from FJ Tombs & Son with R Richins 46kg to 285p/kg and Johnjoe Morris 47kg to 279p/kg with JP Page & Sons 48kg to 272p/kg. Weight making the trade bearbale throughout when returning an all in avg of £112. Export lambs grossing a top of £134 for 44kg from R Richins and £132 42kg and 44kg. Overall weight back on the week but still totting up well throughout seeing a top of £150.50 for 65kg for Alwyn Williams and £148 for 60kg from MM Clarke & Sons. FJ Tombs £147, £144, £142.50 and £142 50 to 58kg. Vendors need to now read the trade. Export demand very low currently and as a result underweight and under finished lambs penalised heavily.



# RUGBY PRIMESTOCK SOCIETY Monday 28th November 2022



#### Home baking - Fruit Cake

#### Ingredients:

225g (8oz) S R Flour

1 tsp mixed spice

½ tsp ground cinnamon

½ tsp ground nutmeg

175g (6oz) butter

175g (6oz) soft brown sugar

1 tbsp black treacle

1 tsp each grated orange and lemon rind

4 eggs

550g (1 1/4 lb) mixed dried fruit

100g (40z) chopped mixed peel

50g (2oz) glacé cherries

15ml milk

#### Method:

Pre-heat the oven to  $150^{\circ}/300^{\circ}$ F/Gas 2. Grease and line an 8in (20cm) deep round cake tin with a double layer of greased greaseproof paper.

Sift flour with spice, cinnamon and nutmeg.

Cream butter with sugar, treacle and orange and lemon rind.

Beat in eggs, one at a time, and adding 1 tbsp of sifted dry ingredients with each other. Stir in mixed fruit, chopped peel, and cherries.

Fold in dry ingredients alternately with milk.

Transfer to prepared tin and smooth top with a knife. Bake for  $4 - 4\frac{1}{2}$  hours or until a skewer comes out clean. Leave in tin for 15 minutes then turn out onto a wire cooling rack.

When cool, pierce the cake at intervals with a fine skewer and feed with a little brandy. Wrap the completely cold cake in a double layer of greaseproof paper and again in foil and store in a cool place for up to 3 months, feeding at intervals with more brandy.

Leave undecorated.


