

Best cattle still over 300ppk. Good R grade 280 plus and the more O grade cattle around that 240/260.

Top Steer was Charlie Jarrom with 309ppk and £2121 for G R Fountaine & Son in the lump G R Fountaine & Son topped the Heifers with 323ppk and in the lump £2176 for R Partridge & Son

Bulls topped twice from P M Wilks at 274ppk and £2345 & Son in the lump for R Partridge & Son travelling over from Ipswich.

The Lamb trade always bring a long term hope. With this the first trading since the Festival and Deadweight Quotes only £6 -£610 every reason for caution from some. National decrease in numbers saw a similar number of buyers at ringside albeit differing faces. An sqq of 315p/kg a massive increase in trade and deadweight over 650p/kg. Meat in demand and quality an improvement to what we have been seeing with only a few lean short on meat forwards. Top today Smart pure bred Texels from C Clayton at 363p/kg with new Vendor K Knight selling 39kg Texels to 354p/kg. Blue Texels 38.5kg to 348p/kg for M Neal and S M Ellingworth 347p/kg. Better shaped and fully finished Lambs regularly 330p/kg mark with Export weight first cross 300p/kg to 320p/kg throughout unless short on finish. Heavier Lambs seeing serious demand today and fought for throughout. Topping at 337p/kg for 47.5kg from MM Clarke & Sons whilst H Hall sold 46kg to 333p/kg and D Ofield properly fed 46kg to 332p/kg. MM Clarke & Sons 51kg to 331p/kg also. In the Lump Export Lambs to £148 for 45kg from WH & R Weston with BF Humphrey & Sons 45kg to £147.50 and Messrs Clayton 45kg at £147. Overall weight the key seeing a top of £175 at 54kg from MM Clarke & Sons whilst J & S Tombs 55kg to £173.50 and

G R Fountaine & Son 55kg to £170. MM Clarke & Sons 51kg at £169. Today 155 Lambs over £150.. Trade likely to steady when numbers come out next week to a more seasonal level. Meat though the keys and some farmers reporting that feeding in the last week have seen unprecedented results.
