One that demand for Export Hoggs has moved forward a step and secondly that Vendors are realising to draw Hoggs to demand i.e less 44 to 49kg Hoggs and instead 43kg and under and 51kg plus best drawn to sell to Vendors advantage. Export best end Hoggs in massive demand. Top today our very own Alan & Anne Tacy 38kg to 379p/kg for Beltex super finished Hoggs bought from this Store ring. Quality today from D W Gurney once again saw 38kg to 366p/kg before Messrs Tacy 42kg at 350p/kg. Last man in saw Norman Deeley 41kg to 344p/kg and large pens 41kg to 330p/kg. Heavies with shape well chased and better supported this week. Topping at 307p/kg for 46kg from J Duggins, Swadlincote with J H Tustian 47kg to 306p/kg and Blue Texels 47kg to 298p/kg for R J Wright. In the lump a top for Export Hoggs of £147 for 42kg Beltex from Alan Tacy also seeing 39.5kg to £144. Norman Deeley 41kg to £141 with Alex Edwards, Uttoxeter 44kgs to £140. Heavies a nice trade but still sluggish for the run of the mill sorts and over fat. Supply simply outweighing demand on Heavies.
