SHOW CATTLE

The 44th Rugby Primestock Society Show & Sale was held on Monday 4th December 2017 with a fantastic number of entries in the cattle sheep and the introduction of our new home baking and butchers classes.

Greg Willis, of Doug Willis Ltd, Cwmbran, took charge of the cattle judging, with some excellent quality cattle forward. Judging began in the penned cattle classes, with Matt Morris taking 1st and 2nd with his 2 lim heifers in the Halter tied steer or heifer (class 7) whilst Jeff Clarke claimed the pairs with 2 belgian blue steers (class 8). Heart of England succeeded in the bull class and T White claimed Barren cow (class 11).

In the halter led classes, F Page achieved first in both the light weight steer (class1) and the midweight steer (class 1a) with his Limousin cross and Blue cross entries. The high entry numbers in the steers meant they were 3 classes, and the heavy weight steer class (class2) was won by S J Timms, whose Lim x steer also took home the heaviest beast in the show prize. Frank Page's smart blue heifer weighing 629kg went on to take first in the heavy weight Heifer class (class 4) and F J Clarke won the lightweight heifer class. SJ Timms' shorthorn steer took first in the Natives (class 5), whilst Matt Morris succeeded in the Young farmers with his lim x heifer (class 6).

When it came to choosing the Supreme Champion, 7 fantastic quality beast were put forward, making decision making tough. In the end after careful consideration, Frank Page with his Heavy weight Heifer came out on top. The Supreme Champion later sold, first in the ring for £400pkg bought by Joseph Morris Butches. Reserve champion also went to F Page with his lightweight steer. The reserve supreme champion sold for £301pkg, weighing in at 597kg, and was purchased by Robert Leach on behalf of Carpenters Farm Butchers. A fantastic display of cattle all round.

In the lump Euro lambs topping at £111 for 42kg from S Mockler ahead of £91.50 for 44.5kg from Henry Tustian and £87.50 for 42kg from S J Lacey. Overall the Commercial lambs topped at £113 for R Laban at 59kg. R & B Smith 57kg to £110 and H L Goode & Son 60.5kg to £109 equal with H Fricker & Sons.
